Monday
Oct 10th All of these 24 hours fine moderate weather wind from E.N.E. Steered S.E. all employed in coopersing and stowing down oil nothing seen to day

Lat 5. 03 S

Tuesday
Oct 11th All of these 24 hours light wind and cloudy with showers of Rain Steered S.E. all employed in Ship duty nothing seen to day

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Wednesday
Oct 12th The first part Strong Gales and squally weather wind E.N.E. Steered S.E. all employed in Ship duty nothing seen to day

Lat 8. 22 South

Thursday
Oct 13th All of these 24 hours light airs and calms from N.E. Steered E.S.E. all employed in Ship duty saw Porpoises

Lat 9. 38 S

Friday
Oct 14th All of these 24 hours light breezes from N.E. Steered East all employed in Ship duty saw blackfish and Porpoises

Lat 10. 27 South

Saturday
Oct 15th All of these 24 hours light airs and calms from the Westward Steered E by S all employed in Ship duty saw Porpoises

Lat 10. 30 South

Sunday
Oct 16th All of these 24 hours light airs and calms Steered E.S.E. nothing seen to day of any account

Oct 17th All of these 24 hours light baffling wind with showers of Rain Steered S.E. at daylight saw Flint Island bearing S by E. dist 10 miles all employed in Ship duty at 6 P.M. saw sperm whale heaved and pulled until sundown came on board and steered S by E
