Nov 23 All of these 24 hours light breezes from
SW to NW Steered ENE all employed
in getting out top gallant standing sail
Nothing seen to day the Easter part foggy

Wednesday
Nov 24 All of these 24 hours light airs from the
NW and calms Steered ENE all employed
in ship duty bent the main Royal Sails
a number of finbacks

Thursday
Nov 25 All of these 24 hours light breezes from
the North Steered East and ENE all
employed in mending sail and wetting
hole saw finbacks and Porpoise

Lat 40.50 South

Friday
Nov 26 All of these 24 hours fresh breezes
from the NNE and cloudy Steered
East by South all employed in ship duty
saw a number of finbacks

Lat 41.42 S

Saturday
Nov 27 All of these 24 hours fresh breezes from
North to NNE Steered East and ENE
all employed in ship duty Nothing
seen to day

Sunday
Nov 28 All of these 24 hours strong breezes
from the NNE Steered East with
cloudy weather at 1 pm took in the
jib Nothing to day

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Monday
Nov 29 All of these 24 hours light airs and
calms with thick fog Steered
ENE all employed in ship duty
saw Porpoise and finbacks

Tuesday
Nov 30 All of these 24 hours light airs and
calms Steered ENE with thick fog
all employed in wetting hole and
repairing the Pump saw Porpoise

Wednesday
Dec 1 The first part of these 24 hours strong
gales from the North with Rain and fog
all Steered ENE all employed in ship
duty the latter part moderate made
sail and Steered East saw Porpoise

Thursday
Dec 2 The first part light breezes from the N
with thick fog and Rain the middle
part cloudy breezes from NW to W then
ENE the latter part clear wind NW
all employed in lashing anchors and
wetting hole at 1 pm carried away the
main Royal yard sent on deck with the
fore one saw finbacks and Porpoise

Dec 3 All of these 24 hours fresh breezes
and clear weather wind from the NW
steered ENE all employed in ship duty
at 11 am saw Right Whale lowered
and chased them in lowering away the
Bow Roosts tacks hoisted and stove her
at 2 pm came on board got Whale

Saturday
Dec 4 All of these 24 hours strong gales and
squally from the NE Steered E by N
at 7 pm took in the jib and spanker
saw finbacks all employed in ship
duty
