Dec 11th

All of these 24 hours moderate clear weather wind N.W. Steered E.N.E. all employed in mending boat and wetting hole at 8 PM. Went on New main top-sail Nothing seen to day

Lat 41. 05 S

Tuesday
Dec 12th

All of these 24 hours moderate clear weather wind from the N.W. Steered E.N.E. all employed in mending sail saw finbacks

Lat 40. 44 S

Wednesday
Dec 13th

All of these 24 hours fine moderate clear weather wind N.W. and N.E. Steered E by N and East all employed in mending sail saw a large number of finback and Porpoise

Lat 40. 58 S

Thursday
Dec 14th

The first part clear with moderate breezes from the West Steered East all employed in ship duty and wetting hole the latter part thick saw finbacks and Porpoise

Friday
Dec 15th

All of these 24 hours light air calm from West to S.W. with Rain Steered E by N all employed in ship duty saw finbacks and Porpoise

All of these 24 hours strong Gales from the N.W. finished Boiling 4 PM saw Nothing to day

Dec 14th

These 24 hours strong Gales from the N.W. commenced Boiling at 7 AM. and finished at 5 PM saw Nothing to day

Lat 41. 35 S

Wednesday
Dec 15th

All of these 24 hours strong Gales from the Northward steering East finished stowing down to day 70th of oil so ends

Lat 41. 28 S

Thursday
Dec 16th

First part of these 24 hours strong Gales from the North with rain later part strong breezes from the Eastward with fog and rain

Dec 17th

First part of these 24 hours light breezes from the Northward steering E by N later part strong winds with thick fog all hands employed at ship duty with hole to day saw Porpoises and got one

All of these 24 hours strong winds from N.W. with rain and fog steering E by N saw finbacks and Porpoises
