These 24 hours strong winds from the Eastward sent down the fore Rigmast and rigged in the fly Gibbon saw finbacks

Dec the 22

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from S^W latter part strong Gales saw Whales loved at 10 AM chased till 6 PM came on board

Thursday
Dec the 23

All of these 24 hours strong Gales from S^W saw Whales at 6 AM lowered and chased till 8 AM boats came on board

Dec the 23

First part of these 24 hours calms and light winds from W^N latter part strong Gales steering S by W saw Whales lowered but did not strike at 7 PM singled reefed the fore and Main Topsail

Dec the 24

All of these 24 hours moderate Gales from Eastward standing to the Southward saw Whales but did not lower to Rugged all hands employed at ship duty

All of these 24 hours light winds from the Eastward with calms saw a Fur Seal so ends

Dec the 26

First part of these 24 light winds from N^W latter part strong Gales from N^W steering S by E saw fine Backs all hands employed at ship duty

Tuesday
Dec the 27

All of these 24 hours strong Gales from the North with rain and fog singled reefed the fore and Main Topsail and furled the mainsail and jib

Wednesday
Dec the 28

First part of these 24 hours strong Gales from the Northward latter part strong Gales took in the mainsail and jib and doubled reefed fore and Main Topsail so ends

Thursday
Dec the 29

All of these 24 hours strong Gales from N^W steering S by E under doubled reefed fore and Main Topsail

Dec the 30

These 24 strong winds from the Westward steering S by E saw porpoises had some Rain

All of these 24 hours strong winds from the Westward with fog and Rain steering S by E

All of these 24 hours light winds from the Westward saw the land at day light on our lee bow saw Whym Backs
