in and bent another

Feb 23

This day begins and ends with  
fine weather saw al Bore on our  
lee bow with hole so ends

Friday  
Feb 24

All of these 24 hours Moderate  
winds with squalls of rain all hands  
Employed at ship duty saw tin Backs

Lat 15° 30' N

Saturday  
Feb 25

This day begins and ends with  
fine weather saw Whales at 4 PM  
lanced and got three and got them  
along side at 9 AM

Sunday  
Feb 26

This day commenced cutting at  
ten AM finished saw Breaches  
on our weather bow

All of these 24 hours light  
winds at day light commenced boiling  
saw a ship on weather quarter

March 4

This day commences with strong breezes  
steering N W all hands employed  
at cleaning ship and painting

Saturday  
March 5

This day begins and ends with  
fine weather all hands employed at  
painting ship saw abundance of rock  
weed so ends

Sunday  
March 6

All of these 24 hours light  
winds and calms steering N W  
saw fine Backs so ends

Monday  
March 7

First part of these 24 hours  
light winds and calms  
saw a ship on starboard bow  
all hands employed at painting  
ship saw Grampuses so ends

Lat 27° 26' N

Tuesday  
March 8

This day commences with light  
winds and calms latter part strong  
breezes from N W steering to Northward  
saw five vessels in sight

Wednesday  
March 9

All of these 24 hours strong  
Gales from NE to SE steering  
N W saw a vessel on weather beam  
all hands employed at ship duty
