

Ship Sloop Cutward bound

Sunday Sept the 23 1849

Begins with a fresh breeze from the N.E. steering N.W. at 1 P.M. set the fore & mainmast standing sail the weather fair the middle a fresh breeze latter part Wind N.W. steering S.E. & ends this 24 hours Lat 35.01 N Long 27.10 W.

Monday Sept the 24

Begins with a fine breeze from the North & steering S.E. with sheet in and at 8 P.M. one sail in sight the latter part a fine breeze & steering S.E. & one sail in sight Lat 34.09 N Long 24.35 W.

Tuesday Sept the 25

Begins with a fine breeze from N.W. & steering S.E. at 8 P.M. hauled S.W. & shifted the standing sail over & a fresh breeze the middle & latter blowing strong & steering S.W. at 1 P.M. hauled S.W. & steering S.W. Lat 31.38 N Long 23.00 W.

Wednesday Sept the 26

Begins with a strong breeze from N at 1 P.M. hauled to N.E. & steering S.W. & set the main & gallant sail the middle and latter part light breezes from E. steering S.W. Lat 29.50 N Long 23.55 W.

Thursday Sept the 27

Begins with light breezes from E and steering S.W. by S. at 5 P.M. wind S.E. the middle part wind hauled to the S. and latter part heading W. by S. & ends there 24 hours Lat 28.12 N Long 24.58 W.

Friday Sept the 28

Begins with a light breeze from S.W. & at 1 P.M. hauled ship to the S.E. the middle & latter part the same and saw nothing of note Lat 27.19 N Long 23.01 W.

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Saturday Sept the 29

Begins with light breezes from S.W. & heading to the S.E. and hauls in the middle & light breeze from N.W. & steering S.W. latter part calm and one sail in sight a fair Lat 26.28 N Long 23.55 W.

Sunday Sept the 30

Begins with calm weather at 3 P.M. & light air from S.E. & steering S.W. the middle a light breeze from E and fine weather latter the same & steering S.W. Lat 25.45 N Long 23.08 W.

Monday Sept the 1 1849

Begins with a light trade from N.E. & steering S.W. with 4.5 fms. haul on & at 1 P.M. set lower stand sail & set a fair breeze the middle & latter part a fresh trade and in the evening the mainsail & one sail in sight. so ends Lat 22.55 N Long 22.30 W.

Tuesday Oct the 2

Begins with a fresh trade from N.E. & steering S.W. by S. at 1 P.M. bent the main sail the middle & latter part a fine trade and steering S.W. by S. and the weather thick Lat 19.54 N Long 25.25 W.

Wednesday Oct the 3

Begins with a fresh trade from N.E. & steering S.W. by S. the middle steering S.W. at 8 A.M. hauled up & so ends and unbent the main & gallant sail to men and bent another one & saw nothing of note Lat 17.27 N Long 25.55 W.
