during I at and so ends during I

Friday Oct the 5

Begins with a light trade from N.E.
during P.M. at 2 P.M. saw black
fish towards got fast to one and the
Green Swan at 7 past 4 P.M. saw the
Whale of Brown having 2 E Dist
14 miles and held in for the Lee
end of it the middle and latter
part heating up and our boats at
10 went on shore so ends

Saturday Oct the 6

Begins with the N. weather and
one boat on shore the wind very
light and working the ship up at
7 the boat came on and brought
some hog & some & put I
and working to windward at 8 P.M.
lower 3 boats and went on shore
at 12 came on and fish 25 hogs
& 2203 fowls and some berries & in
I put off with a strong trade from N.E.
so ends Lat 14.55 N Long 24.48 W

Sunday Oct the 7

Begins with a strong trade &
during P.M. at 2 P.M. located
under the Lee of the Island the
middle and latter part a fine trade
& during P.M. used one sail in
sight Lat 15.25 N Long 24.46 W

Monday Oct the 28. 1859

Begins with a fair trade from N.E.
during P.M. the middle and
latter part a fine trade and in the
at work on rigging, I saw 6 sail
to day. Lat 15.08 N Long 24.57 W
Sun 25.15 W

Tuesday Oct the 29

Begins with a fine trade from
N.E. & during P.M. employed at
work on the rigging the middle & latter
part a light breeze from S.W. at
1 A.M. a squall from S.E. & heavy
rain & ruff so mends one sail in
our wake. Lat 15.45 N Long 24.02 W

Wednesday Oct the 30

Begins with a strong wind from
the S. and ruff down & heavy rains
at 3 P.M. the weather better and put
sail on at 6 hoisting W. & Tack to
the S.E. the middle & latter part
calm and rainy & two sail in sight
so ends Lat 15.34 N Long 23.55 W

Thursday Oct the 31

Begins with a calm and very hot
sun at 4 P.M. took a light air from
the North during I and an English
brig close to us beyond latter the
middle & latter part squalls of rain &
not much wind at 11 A.M. saw 3 sail
and so ends Lat 15.34 N Long 23.50 W

Friday Oct the 12

Begins with rain & 3 boats of coffee to fish
& the boats came on, bar & got fish at
8 we took a very heavy squall from S.E.
and a plenty of rain the middle & latter
part a fine weather and no wind at
9 P.M. a boat came on, bar from the
Gov Hopkins bound Lat 15.12 N Long 23.51 W
