Saturday Oct. the 13

Begins with a light air from the
S.E. heading to the S. & sail in sight
the middle part the wind back to S.W.
& heading W. the middle & latter part
a light breeze from S.E. and steering
S.W. & sail in sight bound
So ends Lat 7.25 N Long 23.08 W.

Sunday Oct. the 14

Begins with light breeze from S.E.
& steering S.W. and sail in
sight & we were beating our black fish
the middle and latter part light breeze
from S.E. and sail in sight bound
So ends Lat 5.38 N Long 23.24 W.

Monday Oct. the 15

Begins with a calm and clear weather
& sail in sight at 8 P.M. took on
squall of rain and a light breeze from
S.W. and at 7 P.M. ship to the S.E.
the middle & latter part raining & a light
air from the N.W. & steering S.W. and
a head swell. Lat 5.10 N Long 23.07 W.

Tuesday Oct. the 16

Begins with calm weather & raining the
middle part squally and heavy. Run
latter part calm. Lat 5.21 N Long 23.00 W.

Wednesday Oct. the 17

Begins with calm weather & dry at 9
P.M. heavy rain and no wind & sail
in sight at 8 P.M. a light air from W.S.W.
the middle & latter part a light air from
the North and a head sea and I jumping
up & down so and employed a minding
sail of sea that then the pieces parts
there we can move there so ends
sail in sight Lat 5.02 N
Long 22.28 W

Ship Supt Outward bound
Thursday Oct. the 18

Begins with a light air from the North
& steering S.W. & employed a minding
old sails & sail in sight and no
chance to get along much owing to a
swell rising from the South and not
wind enough to turn it the middle
& latter part a light air from the West
& steering S.W. & sail in sight
so ends Lat 4.50 N Long 22.18 W.

Friday Oct. the 19

Begins with a light breeze from the
S.E. & steering S.W. at 8 P.M. about
calm & sail in sight the middle &
latter part a light breeze from S.E. and
steering S.W. & sail in sight
employed a minding sails so ends
the 24.00 Lat 6.45 N Long 23.46 W.

Saturday Oct. the 20

Begins with a light breeze from S.W.
& heading S.W. by W. and sail
in sight the middle and latter part a
fine breeze from S.E. and heading
S.W. by W. Lat 2.35 N Long 23.50 W.

Sunday Oct. the 21

Begins with a fresh trade from
S.W. & heading S.W. by W.
about 8 sail in sight then the
same at 8 P.M. took squall
& carried away the top sail from the
middle and latter part a strong breeze
& in company with 4 sail so ends
with all sail set that we can make
so ends Lat 4.04 N Long 23.28 W.
