

Ship left Saturday morning
Monday Nov. the 12 1849
Began with a light breeze from N & E
thruing E & E. 4 past midday saw a
rite whale & lower and chased but
did not get on at 2 P.M. came on board
and kept on our course E. S. E. the
middle & latter part a light breeze
and hauled in about midday
sails & so forth Lat 34.14 Long 3.30 W.

Tuesday Nov. the 13
Began with a light air from E & E
and heading S. E. at 4 P.M. upland
the main top sail & bent another on
the foremast & latter part a breeze from
E. to S. E. and a plenty of Fin Back &
Thump Back in sight and so on
then 2. hours Lat 38.36 Long 5.28 W.

Wednesday Nov. the 14
Began with a fine breeze from E. & E.
and heading to the N. E. at 4 P.M.
tack ship to the S. the middle & latter
part a light breeze from E. by S.
heading S. by E. 4 hands employed a
minding sails Lat 38.18 Long 5.30 W.

Thursday Nov. the 15
Began with a light breeze from S. by
S. & heading S. by E. and a plenty of
Fin Back the middle & latter part Calm
very sail in sight and so on then
2. hours Lat 39.04 Long 5.10 W.

Friday Nov. the 16
Began with calm weather at 5 P.M.
a light breeze from N & E & thuring
E. by S. and two sail in sight the middle
part a fine breeze at 8 P.M. saw
rite whale & lower but could not get
on at 9 came on board so on & 3
sail in sight Lat 38.40 Long 3.01 W.

Ship left Saturday morning
Sunday Nov. the 17
Began with a fine breeze from
N & thuring E. by S. at 3 P.M. wind
hale to S. W. a fresh breeze
the middle part the same at 8 A.M.
wind very light and saw right whale
lower and got fast to one and at 11
took him along side & got ready to
cut Lat 38.11 Long 00.20 W.

Monday Nov. the 18
Began with calm and at 1 P.M.
then getting at 4 finished at 6 past
lower for more whale but did
not get on the middle part a light
air from E. and at 4 P.M. tack ship
to the S. with latter part light air
& two sail in sight so on & then
2. hours Lat 34.53 Long 00.10 E.

Tuesday Nov. the 19
Began with a light breeze from
E & heading S. by E. & two sail in
sight the middle part Calm latter
part much the same & saw a right
whale & lower & chased but did
not get on so on & 3 sail in
sight Lat 38.55 Long 1.07 E.

Wednesday Nov. the 20
Began with a light air from S. E.
& Fin Chase of a whale at 3 P.M.
boats came on board at 7 P.M.
bore heading the latter part the
weather & at 4 past 11 spoke ship
Jefferson of N. London 20 days out
120 blb Oil so on Lat 34.53 Long 2.00 E.
