

Swift Sailed bound
Wednesday Nov the 21

Begins with a fine breeze from
N.W. heading S.E. & sailing
in company with the ship in
the middle & latter part a breeze from
E. and heading S.E. and two sail
in sight Lat 41.29 S Long 4.20 E

Thursday Nov the 22

Begins with a fine breeze from E.
& heading S.E. & a ship & bark in
sight the middle part fine weather
fast in sail to N.E. heading E.S.E.
the weather thick Lat 40.51 S Long 4.20 E

Friday Nov the 23

Begins with a fine breeze from N.E.
& heading E.S.E. the weather thick and
only ship & bark in view the middle
& latter part a thick fog and a good
breeze from the North and steering
E.S.E. with standing sails set and one
sail in sight Lat 42.51 S Long 10.31 E

Saturday Nov the 24

Begins with fair weather and wind
from the North at 1 P.M. hauled to N.W.
& steering E.S.E. the middle part foggy the
latter part a fine breeze and three sail in
sight so ends Lat 42.26 S Long 15.05 E

Sunday Nov the 25

Begins with a fresh breeze from N.W.
& steering E.S.E. and the weather thick
the middle & latter part blowing a gale
and steering E.S.E. Lat 41.51 S Long 18.10 E

Monday Nov the 26

Begins with a gale from N.W. & steering
E.S.E. and a heavy swell on the middle part
blowing heavy and squalls of hail latter
part squally Lat 42.08 S Long 22.50 E

Swift Sailed bound
Tuesday Nov the 27

Begins with a gale from W and steering
E.S.E. and fore & mainmast standing sail in
& lowers out at 8 the gale increasing
& took in steering sail & main top
gallant sail the middle part miss a
boat sea on and latter part drift the
main topsail and so ends steering
E. Lat 40.51 S Long 28.25 E

Wednesday Nov the 28

Begins with a heavy gale from W.
& steering E. at 5 P.M. took another reef
in the main topsail at 7. Lost the
main topmast at 4 past 7 took in the
2nd top sail & fore sail & set to heaving
S.E. close reef the main topsail and
it blowing very heavy at 9 P.M. took in
the main topsail at 1 A.M. the gale
abated some & put her on her course S.E.
by E. latter part set light sails so ends
the 24 hours Lat 40.26 S Long 28.55 E

Thursday Nov the 29

Begins with a fair breeze from S.W. & steering
S.E. & a main top sail & main
top gallant sail the middle and latter
part a fine breeze and steering E.S.E.
and N.W. Lat 40.28 S Long 32.00 E

Friday Nov the 30

Begins with a fine breeze from N.W.
& steering E.S.E. with all sail set and
will blow the middle and latter
part a fine breeze and all sail
set so ends Lat 40.21 S Long 36.00 E
