Tuesday Dec the 11. 1849
Begins with a fine and fresh breeze
from the North land at 4 P.M. hauled to
N.W. and light sail in & past a point
of weight abate the middle blowing
hard from W. and under double reef of
Main Top sail & F. Sail latter part
close reef them and the gal very heavy
so ends Lat 39° 59' S Long 85° 20' E

Wednesday Dec the 12
Begins with a heavy gale from W.
& S.W. and S. pushed close reef of
Main Top sail & F. Sail at 8 P.M. the
gale abating some the latter part fair
weather & S.W. Studding sail & past an
Isle English Ship, Stirling E. small
Stirling E. Lat 38° 33' S Long 89° 48' E

Thursday Dec the 13
Begins with fine weather and N.W.
& Stirling E. S. and a ship astern
the middle and latter part fine weather
and underline sail and so forth &
saw nothing Lat 38° 36' S Long 93° 00' E

Friday Dec the 14
Begins with a moderate breeze from
the North & Stirling E. S. and the
weather fine at 2 P.M. heard a gun
& Main Top sail & F. Topmast stay sail
the middle and latter part fine weather &
breeze variously improved so ends Stirling
E. S. Lat 34° 47' S Long 96° 00' E

Saturday Dec the 15
Begins with a moderate breeze from N.W.
& Stirling E. S. at 4 P.M. sent a new
Mizen Top sail at 12 P.M. hauled up, sent
at 8 P.M. made the Island of Amsterdam
bearing S.E. dist 20 miles and put up
hast at 7 sent to boats in a fishing
small Lat 37° 52' S Long 97° 52' E

Ship kept Crossing the Indian Ocean
Sunday Dec the 16
Begins with a fine breeze from the
W. and two boats a fishing at 8 P.M.
the same of and put away E. S. E. at 9
a fine breeze from N.W. and latter part
wind W. and studding sail set so ends
the 24 hours Lat 37° 59' S Long 89° 35' E

Monday Dec the 17
Begins with a light breeze from W. &
Stirling E. S. with all sail set & the
middle part the same latter part light
air from N.E. & in place a firing a boat
& letting up rigging and so forth so ends
the 24 hours Lat 37° 55' S Long 83° 08' E

Tuesday Dec the 18
Begins with a light air from N.E. &
Stirling E. S. and weather thick and
some rain the middle and latter
part a light air and mending the
Main sail so ends the 24 hours
Lat 37° 48' S Long 84° 20' E

Wednesday Dec the 19
Begins with a calm and some rain
at 6 P.M. a light air from E. & heading
S.E. and the sail in sight the middle
& latter part rainy wind from E. & N.E.
and heading S.E. Lat 37° 30' S Long 83° 15' E

Thursday Dec the 20
Begins with a fresh breeze from E. and
heading S.E. and light sail the weather
thick & a plenty of rain the middle part
heavy rain & wind & bore to at 10 P.M.
the gale abated some & made some sail
the wind hauled to N.E. & Stirling E. S.
so ends Lat 36° 10' S Long 87° 30' E
