

Ship Swift of Andersons Lane

Saturday Jan the 12 1850

Begins with strong winds from N.W. and a heavy swell on & during N.W. & at 3 P.M. shook out reef & set main & Jallant sail the middle part a strong breeze and squally latter part much the same & end Lat 39.53 S Long 157.55 E

Sunday Jan the 13

Begins with a fresh breeze from S.W. & during N.W. & at 4 P.M. set 1/2 main & 1/2 fore & got past the ^{Thetuan} at 5 P.M. took him along side and a heavy swell on at 5

A.M. Com. cutting and ends with a light breeze from S.W. and a very heavy swell on Lat 39.54 S Long 158.21 E

Monday Jan the 14

Begins with a light air from S.W. and a heavy swell on & a calmy at 5 P.M. finished and at 9 Com. sailing the middle part a light breeze from the North and a very heavy swell on so much Lat 39.58 S Long 158.08 E

Tuesday Jan the 15

Begins with a fresh breeze from the North & sailing at 5 P.M. came ship to the N.W. and the weather thick the middle part the same at 5 A.M. saw 2 whales & 1 large but could not get on at 8 came aboard and a strong breeze on and working to windward Lat 39.48 S Long 158.27 E

Wednesday Jan the 16

Begins with a strong wind from N.W. and sailing at 5 P.M. saw 1/2 whale going very quick to windward and did not lower the middle part a gale & heavy rain & tempest latter squally & wind N.W. Lat 39.55 S Long 158.60 E

Thursday Jan the 17 1850

Begins with a fresh breeze from N.W. and at 2 P.M. made sail heading to the South at 7 P.M. took in sail for the night & at three watches the latter part light air from N.W. heading to the North Lat 39.28 S Long 159.02 E

Friday Jan the 18

Begins with a light air & calm at 4 past three saw 1/2 whale at a great distance & going quick & 1/2 saw and could not get up with them at 8 came aboard and a light air from N.E. the middle and latter part a light air from the N.E. and in the forenoon the air between decks Lat 39.54 S Long 159.11 E

Saturday Jan the 19

Begins with a light breeze from N.E. and during to the N.W. at 5 P.M. shortened sail for the night the latter part fine weather and calm N.W. & saw nothing of note so much Lat 40.04 S Long 158.23 E

Sunday Jan the 20

Begins with a fine breeze from N.W. heading S.W. and all sail out at 7 P.M. put ship to the north and shortened sail for the night the middle & latter part a fresh breeze from N.W. and S.W. and heading from S.W. to N.W. & saw nothing Lat 39.49 S Long 158.30 E

Monday Jan the 21

Begins with a fresh breeze from the North and heading to the West the middle & latter part fine weather and employed mending 1/2 top sail and at other work Lat 39.15 S Long 158.06 E
