Friday April 13th 1850
Begins with a light air from the
land made sail steering to the
Eastward at 4 P.M. saw a sail to
Windward steering for us at 6.
took in light sails for the night
the latter part spoke Bark Bostonian
of Boston from San Francisco 42 days
sailed Lat Long

Saturday April 14th
Begins with a light air from the
N.W. and in company with the Bostonian
of Boston and the George of N Bedford
& Submarine Tattler of Hull rises 500
the latter part fine and on sail in sight
Sunday April 15th

Begins with a light breeze from S.E.
steering to the N.E. at 3 P.M. spoke
the London Packet 26 months out saw
the Middle and latter part Calm &
saw swimmers of water so much that
4 hours Lat 31.33 S. Long 177.15 E

Monday April 16th
Begins with a Calm to and no
headway on and in company with the
L. Packet of 4 the latter part Calm
and saw nothing of note Lat 31.38 S
Long 177.50 E

Tuesday April 17th
Begins with a light air and begins
and in company with the London Packet
of Fairhaven the latter part a fine
breeze from N.E. and heading E.S.E.
and on sail in sight under our
see so much improved a steering a
thanked & so forth Lat 32.17 S.
Long 179.40 E.

Can't find Whales

Wednesday April 18th 1850
Begins with a fine breeze from N.E.
and heading E.S.E. and at 5 P.M. shortened
sail for the night the Middle and latter
part a fresh breeze and heading to the
Eastward and on sail in sight so much
and no whale Lat 33.08 S. Long 178.48 W

Thursday April 19th 1850
Begins with a fine breeze from N.E.
and heading E.S.E. and at 5 P.M. shortened
sail for the night the latter part heading
to the N.W. and saw white water and
saw for it but did not find out what
it was so much Lat 33.35 S. Long 178.35 W
by Lines 178.24 W

Friday April 20th 1850
Begins with a light breeze from the North
and heading to the Eastward at 8 shortened
sail for the night and at 4 saw a plenty
of Black Fish round the ship the
Middle and latter part a fresh breeze
from the North & heading E by N & N
& so much Lat 33.46 S. Long 177.10 W

Saturday April 21th
Begins with a fresh breeze from N and
thick weather and heading to the Eastward
at 5 Corn raining and ruff down at 4
took in 2 & 4 Mizen Topsail at 12 the wind
had to W. at 4 P.M. it haled out to S.W.
W. and a fresh breeze and steering N
W. so much Lat 33.19 S. Long 177.13 W
by Lines 176.43 W

Sunday April 22th
Begins with a fine breeze from S.W. and
thick weather and steering N. at 6 Left to
W the latter part steering of to the N.W.
and saw nothing so much that 2 hours
Lat 33.10 S. Long 177.54 W
by Lines 177.46 W
