

Ship left a crossing N.W.
Saturday May 18th 1850
Begins with a light breeze from
W.S.W. and heading N.W. and
boiling at 8 P.M. move ship to the
South the middle part very squally
and heavy rain & cold down the
works the latter part much the
same good sound Lat 27° 04' S Long 178° 20' W

Sunday May 19th
Begins with squalls of rain and
rain wind W. at 2 P.M. finish
boiling and had a very heavy squall
and heading to the South the
latter part very heavy squalls from W.S.W.
and fore sail in Lat 27° 22' S Long 177° 48' W

Monday May 20th
Begins with a gale from W.S.W. and
heading to N.E. P.M. a bad sea on and
put 50 bl. of oil down in the boiler
room and wear ship to the N.W. the
latter part more moderate and employed in
stowing down so ends Lat 27° 02' S
Long 177° 40' W

Tuesday May 21st
Begins with strong breezes from
S.W. and heading to the S.E. and
moving down at 2 P.M. wear ship to
the Westward the latter part fair weather
and stowing down at midnight
finish at 10 so ends Lat 26° 35' S Long 177° 40' W

Wednesday May 22nd
Begins with fine weather and wind
S.W. at 6 P.M. shortened sail for the
night the latter part very squally and
wind from W.S.W. and took in fore &
mizen topsail & close reef the main
so ends Lat 26° 46' S Long 177° 59' W

Thursday May 23rd 1850
Begins with heavy squalls from S.W.
and heading to the North
the middle part the same
latter part a bad swell on and
blowing strong & employed a breaking
out trucks in the fore peak and
so forth Lat 26° 04' S Long 178° 20' W

Friday May 24th
Begins with a strong breeze from the
South and heading N.W. and
a line to the middle part fair
latter squally and wind from S.W.
& employed stowing down
and so forth Lat 25° 15' S Long 178° 40' W

Saturday May 25th
Begins with squally weather and
clouds short sail heading S.W.
and employed a minding store boat
and the cooper on pipe shuttles
bread the latter part at work on the
boat and stowing down into pipes
and so ends with a breeze from
S.W. Lat 25° 14' S Long 178° 55' W

Sunday May 26th
Begins with squally weather and
wind S.W. & S.E. the middle or
calm and squalls of rain the middle
and latter part fair weather and wind
from W to S.W. and heading to the
South with all sail set Lat 24° 39' S
Long 179° 30' W

Monday May 27th
Begins with a light breeze from S.W. and
staring in the middle part moderate at
9 A.M. heading on from the North and at 10
a gale and bore to heading E. S. E.
at 11 took in main & sail it blowing
very hard Lat 24° 15' S Long 179° 45' W
