

Saturday July 27th 1850

Begins with a strong wind from
S.W. heading N.W. at 8 P.M.
The ship took in, main sail
heading S.W. to the middle square
at 1 P.M. the 2^d of W. and in about
3 P.M. took in, main sail, a
strong breeze Lat 52° 37' S. Long 171° 55' W.

Sunday July 28th

Begins with a strong wind from
S.W. heading N.W. at 4 P.M.
The ship took in, main sail, on the
wind to the North heading N.W.
at 10 were ship to the
P. and short sail at 2 P.M.
were ship to the North. Lat
51° 40' S. and heading to the
North so wind Lat 54° 14' S. Long 172° 15' W.

Monday July 29th

Begins with a fresh trade wind
heading S.W. at 8 P.M. Shortened
sails for the night. Land being
240 miles distant the middle and
latter part a fine breeze and heading
to the North Lat 54° 55' S. Long 172° 32' W.

Tuesday July 30th

Begins with a fine breeze from E.
and heading to the North at 4
P.M. spoke bark. Rose of 18° built
11 months. Out 150 lbs. of whale
the latter part in company with
the bark. So wind heading to
the N.W. Lat 55° S. Long 173° 35' W.

Wednesday July 31st

Begins with a fine breeze from E.
and heading N.W. in Co. with the
Rose of 18° built. The latter part
fine weather and running main sail
so wind Lat 55° 41' S. Long 173° 48' W.

Thursday Aug 1st 1850

Begins with fine weather and strong
S.W. wind over the sea.
at 8 P.M. Left to heading to the
North and took in, sail the
latter part steering N.W. & N.W.
over the ground Lat 55° 41' S. Long 174° 15' W.

Friday Aug 2nd

Begins with a light breeze from
E. & steering N.W. at 8
P.M. Left to E. in company with
the Rose middle part steering to
the S.W. and the latter part steering
up the main rigging so wind
these 24 hours Lat 55° 15' S. Long 174° 32' W.

Saturday Aug 3rd

Begins with fine weather and at
dark on rising at 1 P.M. saw
black fish. Toward but not seen
in company with the Rose.
the middle part from a latter part
steering N.W. by N. at 7 past 10
saw 12 whales and got past
to 4 and over the Iron ore sound
the 24 hours Lat 55° 08' S. Long 174° 35' W.

Sunday August 4th

Begins with fine weather and
a whaling at 4 P.M. got the third
whale. 115 lbs. 15 lbs. 15 lbs.
to cut at 5 A.M.

Can cutting
at 9 got the two small ones in and
so made a cutting the large whale &
the Rose in sight a cutting and
Lat 55° 24' S. Long 174° 50' W.
