Saturday Aug 17th

Begins with fine weather and
saw nothing of note at 9 P.M.
Spoke Ship George of Nantucket
16 months out 150 lbs the latter
part heading to the S.E. and the
same in sight so ends and see
whaled. Lat 10.45 S. Long 179.57 E

Sunday Aug 18th

Begins with a fair breeze and
heading to the S.E. at 5 P.M.
Fast Ship to the North the middle
and latter part fine and heading
N.N.W. Lat 10.31 S. Long 179.30 E

Monday Aug 19th

Begins with fine weather and heading
S.E. at 4 past 2 saw 50 whales to
windward and at 4 past three lower
streets 1000 and 1000 and then a large
side the middle part good but not
at 5 P.M. came heading at head on
finished sound Lat 10.20 S. Long 178.57 E

Tuesday Aug 20th

Begins with fine weather and at 15
P.M. came heading and heading to the
S.E. the latter part heading to the North
and saw nothing. Lat 10.15 S. Long 178.57 E

Wednesday Aug 21st

Begins with a fresh breeze from E
and heading N.N.E. and heading at
9 A.M. Whirlwind and so ends with
a strong breeze and light sails
in. Lat 10.00 N. Long 179.00 E

Thursday Aug 22nd 1850

Begins with a strong breeze from
E and heading to the S.E. East
by the wind the latter part squally
and a work a Coopering Oil and heading
to the S.E. Lat 10.03 S. Long 178.54 E

Friday Aug 23rd

Begins with a strong breeze from
the Eastward and heading S.E. and at
work a Coopering Oil the latter part
a strong breeze and the weather
very squally. Lat 10.06 S. Long 179.18 E

Saturday Aug 24th

Begins with squally weather and
squally clouds at 3 P.M. fine and
and weather squally and squally
Topsails on at 7 P.M. saw 1000
whales going to windward and
did not get up nor a word to
lower part then so ends heading
to the north. Lat 10.58 S. Long 179.11 E

Sunday Aug 25th

Begins with a fresh breeze from
E.N.E. and heading N. at 3 P.M. Fast
Ship to the S.E. the middle part very
squally and squally Topsails the latter
part heading N.N.W. and saw
branches on Fast for them but there
was not seen after so ends a strong
breeze from N.E. Lat 10.58 S. Long 178.54 E

Monday Aug 26th

Begins with a strong breeze from E.N.E
and heading to the North the middle
and latter part the same and saw
nothing of note so ends with squally
weather. Lat 11.15 S. Long 178.16 E
