

On the Line

Friday Sept 8th

Begins with a light breeze from E. S. E. and heading S. W. at 8 P. M. put ship to the North & the latter part fine a 11 A. M. saw three whales but could not get one. Lat 44° 11' S. Long 177° 15' E

Saturday Sept 9th

Begins with a fine breeze from E. S. E. & S. W. Chase of whales at 8 P. M. took the boat up and hauled to the E. S. E. the middle part very squally and stormy sail the latter part rain and saw braches and rain for them but did not see them after, so could not finish - Stowing down meat and one ship in sight & no whales Lat 44° 55' S. Long 177° 00' E

Sunday Sept 10th

Begins with squally weather and wind E. S. E. and under short sail the latter part fine and saw nothing of note Lat 44° 24' S. Long 177° 45' E

Monday Sept 11th

Begins with a fine trail and heady to the S. E. and at 4 P. M. saw a brachy seen far it but saw nothing of it after the latter part two ships in sight and so could not go whales Lat 44° 40' S. Long 178° 13' E

Tuesday Sept 12th

Begins with fine weather and a heading the main sail at 8 P. M. spoke ship Georges and Oruga of Nantucket the latter part heading to North and saw nothing of note so could not Lat 45° 06' S. Long 178° 01' E

South of the Line

Wednesday Sept 11th

Begins with a fresh trade from the Eastward and heading to the North and one ship in sight so at 8 P. M. shortened sail for the night the latter part heading to the North and saw nothing of note so could not Lat 34° 30' S. Long 178° 01' E

Thursday Sept 12th

Begins with fine weather and heading to the North at 8 P. M. put ship to the South the middle latter part calm and at 11 P. M. on the fore sail a mackerel it so could not Lat 34° 34' S. Long 177° 37' E

Friday Sept 13th

Begins with a calm and under the fore sail at 4 P. M. shortened it and the weather calms the latter part a light breeze from N. E. and employed a Scaphing and cleaning the ship. Outrigger so could not show Lat 44° 09' S. Long 178° 34' E

Saturday Sept 14th

Begins with light weather and wind from N. E. and heading E. S. E. & employed a cleaning ship the latter part Spanish and fair weather Lat 44° 33' S. Long 178° 58' E

Sunday Sept 15th

Begins with fine weather and wind from S. S. E. and heading E. by S. wind very light the latter part the same and steering S. E. and saw nothing of note so could not show Lat 5° 09' S. Long 179° 20' E
