Tuesday Sept 26th

Begins with a calm & a fairing
Ship the Middle part & Calm
saw nothing the latter part a light
breeze from E. Lat 4.22 S. Long 179.25 E

Wednesday Sept 27th

Begins with a fine breeze from
E. N. E. and heading N. and saw
black fish and birds but no
whales the middle & latter part
fine and fairing pointing Ship
so ends Lat 3.02 S. Long 179.48 E

Thursday Sept 28th

Begins with a light breeze from
E. S. E. and heading to the N. E.
at 6 P.M. sent Ship to the S. the
middle part the same latter part
improved a fairing till so ends
and saw nothing Lat 3.32 S. Long 179.50 E

Friday Sept 29th

Begins with a fine breeze from E. and
heading to the South and improved
a fairing breeze at 5 P.M. finished
and the weather equally the middle and
latter part the same and saw nothing
of note Lat 4.01 S. Long 179.59 E

Saturday Sept 30th

Begins with a light breeze from S. E.
and heading to the North the middle
and latter part light and from the
S. E. and heading to the N. E. and
saw nothing of note Lat 3.54 S.
Long 179.58 E

Sunday Sept 31st

Begins with a calm and rain the middle
part squally and under short sail the
latter part a fresh breeze from E. S. E. and
heading N. Lat 3.11 S. Long 179.58 E

Monday Sept 30th 1850

Begins with a fresh breeze from E. N. E.
and heading N. at 8 P.M. started
sail for the night the latter part
a fresh breeze from E. N. E. and head
N and imploy a falling Culiv. Points
to so forth Lat 1.33 S. Long 179.43 E

Tuesday Oct 1st 1850

Begins with a fine breeze and pleasant
weather and heading N. by W. by the
wind at 6 P.M. kept the Ship
for the night the latter part fine
weather and no ship in sight and
no whales Lat 1.03 S. Long 179.15 E

Wednesday Oct 2nd

Begins with fine weather and
at 1 P.M. spoke Ship Ensign of
Nantucket and hove to a whale
boat from her the latter part fine
weather and steering to the N. W. E.
so ends Lat 0.53 S. Long 178.52 E

Thursday Oct 3rd

Begins with a fine breeze from
N. E. and steering to the
N. W. at 5 P.M. started sail for
the night the latter part pleasant
weather and heading to the South
and saw nothing Lat 0.56 S. Long 178.11 E

Friday Oct 4th

Begins with fine weather and at work
on the boat David and at 1 P.M. saw
black fish and birds but could not get
on to them the latter part fine and
at work on a boat & rigging and
so forth and no whales to be seen
to day Lat 0.46 S. Long 178.00 E
