Tuesday Nov 12th

Begins with a fine breeze from the North & stirring S.E. by E. the middle part wind backing and heading from S.E. to S. latter part a fine breeze from S. and increased steamed down 20 lbs of Oil and finished of the Main Hold so ended these 24 hours & and no whales Lat 53° 35' S. Long 175° 42'

Wednesday Nov 13th

Begins with a fine breeze from E. and heading S.E. at 8 P.M. took in Mizzen & Mainland sail the middle and latter part a strong trade and heading S.E. and saw nothing Lat 52° 20' S. Long 175° 44'

Thursday Nov 14th

Begins with a fresh trade from E. by S. and heading S.E. and the middle part the same the middle part fair latter squally and heading from S. to S.E. Lat 51° 44' S. Long 175° 47'

Friday Nov 15th

Begins with fresh breeze from E. and squally and at 4 P.M. had a heavy squall from N.E. and took in light sail & double reef the topsails the middle and latter part the same and heading from S.E. to S. and saw nothing of note Lat 51° 20' S. Long 175° 50'

Saturday Nov 16th

Begins with squalls from E. and light sail in & topsails double reef at 6 P.M. sailing the middle & latter part the same and saw no whales to day Lat 51° 55' S. Long 175° 49'

Sunday Nov 17th

Begins with squally weather and from E. and S.E. & heading from S.E. to S. the middle and latter part a strong breeze from E. and heading S.E. to S. Lat 50° 55' S. Long 175° 40'

Monday Nov 18th

Begins with a strong breeze from E. and heading S.E. the middle and latter part the same and heading the fly set & sailed Lat 50° 49' S. Long 175° 38'

Tuesday Nov 19th

Begins with strong trade from E. and heading S.E. and double reef topsails the middle and latter part a fresh breeze and heading S.E. & S. by S. Lat 49° 23' S. Long 175° 06'

Wednesday Nov 20th

Begins with a strong breeze from E. N. E. and stirring S.E. by S. at 1 P.M. kept up S. by E. the middle part stirring S. latter rain & stirring S.E. and the weather fair and thick Lat 48° 40' S. Long 175° 06'

Thursday Nov 21th

Begins with a fresh breeze from N. N. E. & rain, stirring S.E. by S. the middle and latter part a strong breeze and heavy rain and stirring S.E. by S. and saw nothing of note Lat 47° 20' S. Long 175° 00'

Friday Nov 22th

Begins with squally weather and wind from N. W. and rain, stirring S.E. by S. at 6 P.M. calm and backing and set down the topsails the latter part a breeze from S. and heading E. S. E. and so ended these 24 hours Lat 47° 01' S. Long 175° 45'

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
