Saturday Nov 23rd

Begins with a fine breeze from the
S. and heading to the S.E. at 8 P.M.
Left ship to the S.W. the middle part
sail to the east winds with light
airs and sun setting Lat 23.15 S Long 178.09

Sunday Nov 24th

Begins with a light air from S. and
heading S.E. at 4 P.M. sail to the
S.W. and wind S.E. the middle and
latter part a fine breeze and heading
S.W. Lat 23.15 S Long 177.55

Monday Nov 25th

Begins with a fine breeze from S.E.
and heading S.W. the middle
and latter part steering S.W. and
wind from E. Lat 23.14 S Long 176.39

Tuesday Nov 26th

Begins with a fine breeze from E.
and steering S.W. and at 2 P.M. sent
down Main. Mast yard and put up
hanks to Main. Mast to the fore and main
the middle and latter part fine and
improved morning Main. Mast and S.
Lat 23.02 S Long 176.55

Wednesday Nov 27th

Begins with fine weather and the
wind E.N.E. and steering S.W. and
at 8 P.M. took in sail for the night
and set three watches the middle and
latter part thick weather and wind W.E.
latter part sent Main. Mast to end
steering S.W. Lat 23.11 S Long 177.05

and no whales to day

New Zealand
Thursday Nov 28th 1850

Begins with a fresh breeze from N.E.
and steering S.W. at 8 P.M. started
sail for the night and sail to the
latter part a strong breeze and heading
S.W. Lat 30.21 S Long 177.02

Friday Nov 29th

Begins with a strong breeze from
W by N and heading to the S.E.
at 4 P.M. took in sail for the night
the latter part a strong breeze and clear
weather and steering of over the ground
to the westward Lat 31.23 S Long 176.59

Saturday Nov 30th

Begins with a strong breeze from N.E.
and clear weather and steering to the
westward and sent down in whale
at 4 P.M. sail to and took in sail
the latter part fine and heading to the
N.W. and saw nothing of note and
the weather fine Lat 30.54 S Long 176.15

Sunday Dec 1st 1850

Begins with fine weather and wind
from E.N.E. and nothing to be seen
the middle and latter part calm and saw
a flock of birds and some fish & a porpoise
but no whales Lat 30.54 S Long 176.29

Monday Dec 2nd

Begins with calm weather and wind
in the East and at 8 P.M. a light
air from S.W. and sail set at 4 P.M.
sail for the night the latter part a fine
breeze from W.N.W. and steering N.N.E.
and employed a messenger to the
to end and no whales to day
Signed of any Lat 30.17 S
Long 177.02
