E. the middle part the same at 8 P.M. saw Cape Brin and stood in for the harbour and at 10 came to anchor in 5 fathoms of water and found ship E. W. Morgan 19 mi. out 330 ship Mary N. B. 140 sp one white whale Bark Risco N. B. 500 sp and so the time is over

Saturday Jan 11th

Begins with a fine breeze from W. and a rising sea and on shore the latter part the same and filling water.

Sunday Jan 12th

Begins with a fine breeze from W. and pleasant weather and on watch on Liberty the middle & latter part a fine breeze from the S. W.

Monday Jan 13th

Begins with a fine weather and a strong wind from the N. W. and getting of water & so forth the latter part the same and so ends.

Tuesday Jan 14th

Begins with fine weather and the wind from W. and a strong clear weather and so forth the latter part the same

Wednesday Jan 15th

Begins with a strong breeze from the N. W. and getting of wood and the latter part on watch on Liberty

Thursday Jan 16th

Begins with a light air from the North and pleasant ship and so forth the latter part the W. Morgan went to sea so ends & painting ship

Friday Jan 17th 1857

Begins with a fine breeze and pleasant weather & a painting ship & so forth the middle & latter the same so ends

Saturday Jan 18th

Begins with a fine weather and fine weather and on watch on Liberty & the latter part the same

Sunday Jan 19th

Begins with a fine weather and on watch on Liberty and heard one man a Native of Mexico hurt on shore with an of by another country man of his the latter part fine and so ends

Monday Jan 20th

Begins with fine weather and on watch on Liberty and the latter part the same

Tuesday Jan 21th

Begins with fine weather and on watch on Liberty and one a Shorn Wounded. I under the doctors hands at 7 P.M. then the Pike came in & then cut 300 lbs the latter part fine weather

Wednesday Jan 22th

Begins with a fine weather and on watch on Liberty the latter part fine and had 2 men run away and so ends & found the Ketchikan and

Thursday Jan 23th

Begins with fine weather and I picked a getting a stick far to get the red dog at 2 P.M. caught the two run away & put them in the Larkup the latter part fine and on being the Ketchikan and took it on shore and at 9 A.M. the W. Morgan of Warren came in 2900 lbs
