

Friday Feb 7th 1851
Begins with a light air from the
S. and steering to the North and
at 2 P.M. past a boat steering E.
at 8 o'clock took in light sails
the latter part calm Lat 32.52 S
Long 177.30 E.

Saturday Feb 8th
Begins with a light air from
the S. E. and steering to the Eastward
the latter part a light breeze and a
sail in sight Lat 32.38 S. Long 178.00 E.

Sunday Feb 9th
Begins with a light air from N.
E. and heading N.W. at 5 P.M.
past ship to the Eastward the middle
part a light air from the North
at 10 A.M. spoke ship Chas. Mitchell
of Nantucket and she had good
cold down Lat 32.54 S. Long 178.54 E.

Monday Feb 10th
Begins with a light breeze from
the North and in company with
the Elizabeth at 5 P.M. passed
and shortened sail the latter part fine
fine and one ship in sight
Lat 32.52 S. Long 178.50 E.

Tuesday Feb 11th
Begins with fine weather and at
1 P.M. spoke the Elizabeth of New
Bedford 1600 T. 350 whale the middle
light breeze & heading to the Eastward
at 5 A.M. saw sp. whales and saw the
Elizabeth take on at 8 o'clock and
we struck on at 10 took him along
side and at 12 so ended in chase
of others

Lat 33.11 S
Long 179.40 E.

Wednesday Feb 12th 1851
Begins with a light breeze from
the N. W. and at 1 P.M. began sailing
at 2 o'clock and one bark in
sight and the Elizabeth a cutting
at 9 P.M. began boiling and the
latter part fine and saw nothing
of note Lat 33.30 S. Long 179.50 E.

Thursday Feb 13th
Begins with fine weather &
boiling and one ship & bark
in sight at 10 P.M. cold down
and then held to S. E. at 6 A.M.
steering of N.W. at 4 saw sp. whales
Lowered Main & one and got one boat
Hove & the line parted at 9 struck
another one and so ended in chase
of others Lat 32.34 S. Long 179.30 E.

Friday Feb 14th
Begins with a fresh breeze from
the S. E. and in chase of whales at 11
gave them up and stood for the dead
whale at 2 took him along side and
lower cutting at 5 got the booby in
& lying by the side and it blowing
strong from S.E.

at 9
P.M. Boiling and
latter part took the ~~Elizabeth~~ head on
board so ended Lat 32.210 S. Long 179.37 E.

Saturday Feb 15th
Begins with fresh breeze from E
and began and a boiling at 9 A.M.
cold down and at 10 o'clock steering down
so ended weather fine Lat 32.54 S. Long 180.00 E.
