

Ship. Receipt W. H. W. from French.
Sunday Feb 16th 1834

Begins with fine weather and
Stowing down in the fore hold
and at 5 P.M. finished for the
night the latter part fine and stowing
up to the Mithard and saying nothing
of note. Lat 33.52 S. Long 179.55 E.

Monday Feb 17th

Begins with a fine breeze from E.
and heading to the South at 1 P.M.
S. M. took ship to the N. E. and
shortened sail for the night.
The latter part a strong breeze from
E. S. E. & stowing down & stowing up
to the North. Lat 32.41 S. Long 179.42 E.

Tuesday Feb 18th

Begins with a strong breeze from
E. S. E. & stowing down and at 6 P.M.
finished and stowing up of N. S. W. under
short sail at 7 P.M. Left to 1 o'clock
up main topsail & hauled the foresail
for the night heading N. E. the
latter part strong breeze from the S. E.
and one sail. Lat 31.31 S. Long 179.55 W.

Wednesday Feb 19th

Begins with fine weather and at 5 P.M.
Spoke Ship Elizabeth & Ship of Indian of
N. B. 15 months out 800 lbs the
latter part a breeze from the S. E. and
boat & three ships in sight 22
black fish Lat 31.21 S. Long 179.29 W.

Thursday Feb 20th

Begins with a light breeze from
the Eastward and here to the N. E.
and mending Starboard boat the
middle part fine the latter part heading
N. E. by N. at Mithard saw 1/2 whale
a fine point to the N. W. so much
the 24 hours Lat 30.39 S. Long 179.00 W.

Ship. Receipt W. H. W. from French.
Friday Feb 21st 1834

Begins with fine weather and at
1 past Mithard lowered for whale 22
at 2 P.M. struck one at 3 took him
along side  and 2 boats in chase
of others at 7 shorted sail the boats and
shorted sail the boats at 6 P.M. came
within at 9 finished at 10 am. Towing
so much. Lat 30.13 S. Long 179.51 E.

Saturday Feb 22nd

Begins with fine weather and a boiling
& mending Starboard boat and wind from
E. S. E. heading to the middle part Mithard
at 5 P.M. finished towing and latter
part all sail out heading to the
South. Lat 30.01 S. Long 179.51 E.

Sunday Feb 23rd

Begins with a light breeze from
the Eastward and heading to the South
at 8 P.M. took in sail for the night
the latter part squally and wind from
the North and stowing to the S. E. so much
the 24 hours Lat 30.40 S. Long 179.66 E.

Monday Feb 24th

Begins with rain weather from
N. N. E. and heading E. at 4 P.M.
took in fore & main topsail and at 7
o'clock the main & hauled the foresail
the middle part a heavy rain and at
8 P.M. took in the main topsail so much
the 24 hours Lat 32.10 S. Long 179.40 W.

Tuesday Feb 25th

Begins with a gale from the North
and here to at 4 P.M. took in fore & main
& set main topsail & foresail heading
E. by N. the latter part fine and all
sail set stowing S. E. by N. wind N. W.
so much. Lat 32.17 S. Long 178.40 W.
