

W. & A. W. from Tuesday Island
Thursday April 3rd 1854

Begins with a strong breeze from
the Eastward and shifting to the S.W.
& W. over the ground but can't find
the whales and our ship in sight
to the Westward. at 8 P.M. took in
sail and the night shading. the
Middle and latter part a strong breeze and
at 10 past 11 A.M. spoke the S. W. Morgan
and made in company heading to
the S. W. Lat 28° 55' Long 179° 57' W.

Friday April 4th
Begins with a strong breeze from E.
and heading to the S. at 1 P.M. took
in Fore & Mizzen topsail and it blowing
to a Gale at 8 took in Fore sail &
Main topsail the Middle and latter part
blowing strong and set Main topsail
to full. Lat 28° 50' Long 179° 55' E.

Saturday April 5th
Begins with a gale from E and
heading to the S. and Fore sail is
and the S. W. Morgan in sight
the Middle & latter part a rain and
wind S. E. Lat 28° 46' Long 179° 26' E

Sunday April 6th
Begins with a fresh breeze from N. E.
and set Fore & Mizzen topsail & F. C. and
making S. E. and at 5 P.M. took in
sail for the night at 1 P.M. a heavy rain
and the wind held to S. W. the latter
part fair weather and all sail set
shifting to the Eastward so made one
sail in sight Lat 29° 02' Long 179° 52' W.
Long by two lines 179° 40' W.
179° 51' W.

Monday April 7th 1854

Begins with a fine breeze from S. E. W.
and shifting to the Eastward over the ground
at 8 P.M. took in sail and left to the
wind S. E. the Middle & latter part rain
& wind S. E. so made under short sail
& no whale Lat 28° 50' Long 179° 00' W.

Tuesday April 8th
Begins with a strong breeze from S. E.
and heading to the Eastward at 2 P.M.
blew up some and set Fore topsail and
Main of N. E. & N. at 3 P.M. took in
sail and Middle part
a fresh breeze at 7 P.M. saw the whales
and at 8 past 10 saw for them and
the wind blowing very strong at 10 went
on to one & boat started mist and sea
at midnight came on board with no
whale Lat 28° 45' Long 179° 07' W.

Wednesday April 9th
Begins with a strong breeze from the
Eastward and a cruising off for the whales
and at 8 P.M. saw them and at 1 hour
and struck a Calfs that was taken
in ²⁸ ~~28~~ ²⁸ and the wind blowing
a gale & very rough the Middle part
& latter blowing hard and Main topsail
is and so made Lat 28° 46' Long 179° 55' W.

Thursday April 10th
Begins with a gale from S. E. E.
and going to round Starboard
heading S. the Middle part moderate
and set Fore sail. latter part Fore & Mizzen
topsail set and taken in again and
was ship to the S. E. and saw nothing
of note Lat 29° 01' Long 179° 40' E.
