Saturday April 25th 1854

Begins with a fine breeze from S.E.
& heading to the Eastward at 6
P.M. took in sail for the night &
the middle part squally latter a strong
breeze from S.E. and heading S.E.
so much Lat 26° 46' Long 178° 42' W.

Sunday April 26th

Begins with a strong breeze from S.E.
& heading S.E. at 8 P.M. took in sail
& was ship to the South the middle &
latter part a strong breeze and under
short sail Lat 27° 03' Long 179° 30' W.

Monday April 27th

Begins with a strong breeze from S.E.
and under double reef and at 2 P.M.
took in Top & Mizzen Top sail and it being
very much and blowing strong, the middle
& latter part the same and fair sail
in so much Lat 27° 43' Long 179° 50' W.

Tuesday April 28th

Begins with a calm from S.E. and
heading S. and at 4 P.M. it
began to moderate in the middle and
latter part blowing strong and a
S.E. sea on Lat by the 28° 04' Long 179° 45' E

Wednesday April 29th

Begins with a calm from S.E.
& heading S. at 7 A.M. were
ship to the S.E. & wind from S.E. and
blowing strong at times and the latter
about the same and a heavy sea on
so much that to hear Lat 28° 07' Long 179° 40' E

Begins with a calm from S.E. and heading
S.E. the middle more moderate at 8
P.M. made sail with a strong breeze and
heading S.E. Lat 27° 25' Long 179° 31' E

Friday May 5th

Begins with a strong breeze from S.E.
& heading S.E. and at work on
ship duty at 8 P.M. took in sail for the
night & the middle squally latter part fair
& sail out so much heading S.E. and nothing
to be seen Lat 28° 28' Long 179° 55' E

Saturday May 6th

Begins with a fine breeze from S.E. and
heading S.E. and no whaler to be seen
to day the middle and latter part squally
weather and saw nothing of note &
employed a minding the main Top sail
at 11 A.M. took ship to the South
Lat 28° 32' Long 179° 50' E

Sunday May 7th

Begins with a fresh breeze from S.E. and
heading S.E. at 8 P.M. took in main
sail & gill for the night the middle
and latter part a fine breeze and fair
weather and saw nothing of note
so much Lat 28° 46' Long 179° 37' W

Monday May 8th

Begins with a fine breeze from S.E. and
heading S.E. at 8 P.M. took in the
flap for the night the middle and
latter part a strong breeze and thick weather
wind from S.E. and at 8 A.M. went
the main sail to down so much
than 24 hours Lat 29° 59' Long 179° 00' W
