Wednesday June 1st 1851

Begins with a gale of wind from the North & rain at 2 P.M. wind pale to W.N.W. and at 3 Made sail steering N.N.E. down to the North the Middle a light breeze from the S. and steering N. the latter part the same & employed a sloop up & down for water latter part of day

Long 178.35 W.

Thursday June 2nd

Begins with a light breeze from the S. & steering N.N.E. the Middle calm latter a light breeze from the S.W. and saw nothing of note so much Lat 23.45 S Long 172.57 W.

Friday June 3rd

Begins with light breezes from the S. and steering N. and at night about East & the river the Middle part Moderate latter the same & saw nothing Lat 22.39 S Long 172.23 W.

Saturday June 4th

Begins with a light air from the S.W. and all sail set. but a gale along shore and no whales the Middle and latter part calm and saw nothing of note so much these 24 hours Lat 22.18 S Long 172.00 W.

Sunday June 5th

Begins with a calm and at 5 P.M. at light air from S. and steering N.N.W. the Middle and latter part a moderate breeze from S. and steering N.N.W. & N.N.E. and thick weather

Monday June 29th 1851

Begins with a light breeze from S. and steering N. and thick weather the Middle and latter part a fine breeze from S. and steering N. by E. and employed a painting ship 24 to 30 parts

Lat 19.45 S Long 172.15 W.

Tuesday June 10th

Begins with a fine trade from S. & steering N. and employed a painting ship in side the Middle and latter part a strong breeze and steering N.N.E. off so much Lat 19.29 S Long 171.18 W.

Wednesday June 11th

Begins with a strong trade from S. & steering N.N.E. the Middle steering N. by E. the Middle part a strong trade Lat 10.11 N. saw the Island of Tortuella bearing N. and so much the wind moderate Lat 15.01 S Long 170.45 W.

Thursday June 12th

Begins with a moderate trade and pending in for the land at 5 P.M. took in light sails at 7 wore ship of shore and one sail in sight to seaward the Middle being of and on at 9 A.M. lowered 2 boats and went in a trache and so much Lat Long

Friday June 13th

Begins with fine weather and seeing of land on and two boats on shore Lat 5 P.M. came of and stood off for the night & 43 bunches of bananas and 2 bags 35 baskets of yams 2 hundred coconuts & the latter part a gale of yams and so forth and so much Lat Long
