

On the Line
Friday July 18th
Began with fine weather wind
blew S. & S.W. at 8 P.M.
took in light sail and hauled up
the boat and the middle part fair
latter part stirring of W. and at west
taking up the main rigging & well
in whales Lat 00.08 N Long 144.56 W

Saturday July 19th
Began with a few birds and stirring
at 1 P.M. saw black fish and
Lorax but got nothing and took up
the boat at 3 P.M. Shortland sail
left to S.E. wind S.N.E. the middle
part fine at 11 A.M. for about part Mr.
Norton of boat so ends this 24 hours
stirring S.W. W. Lat 00.07 N Long 140.16

Sunday July 20th
Began with a few birds from E.
and stirring S. with a fair weather
and a Moon in Irons and Mat of
Lute at 3 P.M. Shortland sail and
left to the wind S.E. by S. the middle
part fine by the wind latter part stirring
of S.W. also saw whales but they
did not to be of whale so ends
this 24 hours Lat 00.25 S Long 140.55

Monday July 21st 1871
Began with strong breeze and stirring
over the ground S.W. at 2 P.M.
Shortland sail & left to S.N.E. the middle
part heading S.E. at 7 left of S.W. over
the ground and at 8 A.M. put Mr Norton
to his duty so ends this 24 hours and
saw nothing of note Lat 00.22 S
Long 142.00 W

On the Line
Tuesday July 22nd
Began with a fine trade and
stirring of S.W. over the ground at 8
P.M. Shortland sail and stirring W. under
short sail at 4 hauled to the south
and at 12 sent to the North and saw a
barb stirring to the S.W. the latter
part stirring of over the ground so ends
saw nothing Lat 00.20 S Long 143.14 W

Wednesday July 23rd
Began with fine weather and stirring
to the S.W. at 8 P.M. took
in sail for the night stirring S.
W. at 12 stirring of S.W. and rain at 4
stirring S.W. by S. and at 8 A.M. saw
whales & Lorax at 10 struck 2 whales
and the weather was breezy so ends
this 24 hours Lat 00.34 S Long 143.30 W

Thursday July 24th
Began with rain weather and at
8 past Meridian took over whale along
side at 8 took the other
and got ready to cut the
weather was rainy & squally
at 6 A.M. came boiling and at 11 finished
and the weather fine and a calm breeze
this 24 hours Lat 00.40 S Long 146.11 W

Friday July 25th
Began with calm and heading to the
North at 2 P.M. a light air from the
S.E. and at 3 came boiling at 8 were
ship to the S. and a strong current setting
to the W. at 7 A.M. saw whales and
a Calm and Lorax and chait at
Meridian struck one and so ends in
Chait Lat 00.19 S Long 148.08 W
