Wednesday Aug 12th 1857
Begins with fine weather and sail
in sight the Middle part the
latter part fine and 6 ships in
sight with the three main Jacks down
so much. Lat 00.04 S. Long 146.36 W.

Thursday Aug 13th

Begins with fine weather and heading
N. N. E. at 1 P.M. saw a large breast and
saw for it but saw nothing of it
at 2 P.M. ship to the South

The latter part heading to the North
and saw one bark steering S. W. and we
employed a steering course in the fore
hold so much. Lat 00.28 S. Long 146.44 W.

Friday Aug 14th

Begins with a strong trade and from
N. and heading N. N. E. at 4 P.M.
passed numerous vessels at 5 P.M.
ship to the South the Middle part a
strong breeze latter part the same and
one sail in sight so much heading
S. E. Lat 00.54 S. Long 146.57 W.

Saturday Aug 15th

Begins with a strong trade and heading
S. E. at 5 P.M. passed ship and from
500 strokes in her. from S. A. M. to S. P.M.
so we have a Leaky ship and at 11 P.M.
5 Lookt ship to the North the Middle
part latter heading to the N. E. and
so much ship in sight and we
whales to be seen to day

Lat 00.12 S. Long 146.26 W.

Sunday Aug 17th 1857
Begins with strong trades and heading
to the N. E. and three ships in
sight at 5 P.M. Jack 1 ship to
the South the latter part saw others and
1 sail in sight so much ends these 26 hours
and no whales Lat 00.13 S. Long 146.46 W.

Monday Aug 18th

Begins with fine weather and heading
to the North at 2 P.M. spoke the
Ship Dismena of N. Bedford 1300 of
Spain the latter part heading S. E. I
saw one black fish but no whales
& three sail in sight so much

Lat 00.44 S. Long 146.47 W.

Tuesday Aug 19th

Begins with a light breeze from
N. E. and heading S. E. and 5
sail in sight and no whales the
latter part fine weather and saw nothing
of note. Lat 1.17 S. Long 146.57 W.

Wednesday Aug 20th

Begins with a fine trade and heading
to the South and at 3 P.M. spoke the
Dismena of N. Bedford and the
Middle part heading N. E. the Middle
latter part fine and saw nothing of note
so much. Lat 00.52 S. Long 146.00 W.

Thursday Aug 21th

Begins with fine weather and heading
N. E. by N. and at 1 P.M. saw the Ship
Dismena a whale under our lee
and put of in chase at 3 P.M. lowered
and struck 3 and at 4 P.M. the three
saw side and saw the ship take one

 at 4 P.M. saw 5 A.M. saw
butter and at 5 P.M. finished and so
much
