Wednesday Sept 10th 1831
Began with light breeze from N.
and heading E.S.E. and all sail set
the middle and latter part moderate &
heading E.S.E. and hands at work
a strong down and strong up rigging
at 4th were ship to the North
and saw nothing Lat 4.54 S. Long 148.02

Thursday Sept 11th
Began with a light breeze from
the Eastward and heading to the North
with all sail set the middle part
fine latter part strong off N.W.
and saw nothing Lat 3.23 S.
Long 148.17 E

Friday Sept 12th
Began with fine weather and wind
from E. and strong N.W. at
past 5 saw three whales 3 miles
off and lowered but Night came
and did not see them out of the
boats at 4th took up the boats and
shortened sail and working off
for the whales the latter part
working of in hope to find them
but saw nothing of them so ends
Lat 2.47 S. Long 147.25 E

Saturday Sept 13th
Began with fine weather and strong
W and at 1 P.M. made head. Island
at 5 got down to it and discharged
6 barrels that we got from there last
year and one that we shipped at
Whale and at 6 put away W for
Rock Island & 2 sail in sight at 11
Left to at 25 part of W and at 8 saw
whales and lowered and struck 4 and lost
one and a half and sund Lat 2.48 S.
Long 145.46 E

Sunday Sept 14th 1831
Began with a strong breeze and boats
of a whaling at 8 P.M. got the three
whales along side ~~and~~  ~~and~~  ~~and~~ 
and lost that were dead and went
at 6 A.M. Com. Cutting at 4
got one in and send the 2
waft whales and send took them very
side and went to cutting  
at midline got them in so ends
with two along side Lat 3.11 S. Long 145.34 E

Monday Sept 15th
Began with fine weather and a cutting
at 5 P.M. finished and were ship to
the South and at 8 Com. boiling the
middle and latter part fine and at
boiling 5 ends Lat 3.34 S. Long 145.01 E

Tuesday Sept 16th
Began with fine weather and a
boiling heading E.S.E. wind from
S.E. the middle and latter part fine
and boiling Lat 3.34 S. Long 145.27 E

Wednesday Sept 17th
Began with light air and at 1 P.M.
Cold down and the weather fair the
latter part squally and wind all around
the compass and nothing to be
seen Lat 2.50 S. Long 145.10 E

Thursday Sept 18th
Began with squally weather and at
last a milder the 1 boat and strong
up. Shuckled & forth at 8 P.M. took
to the S.E. and shortened sail for the
night the middle and latter part fine
weather and wind from N.E. and
mild E.S.E. Lat 3.53 S.
Long 146.10 E
