Sunday Sept 28th 1850

Begins with fine weather and
beginning heading to the North
at 8 P.M. went ship to the S.
at 10 A.M. finished looking and measuring
of S. & small Lat 4.56 S. Long 175.27 E

Monday Sept 29th

Begins with squally weather and
finishing of S.M. and a fishing the
Main top gallant back sheet that
we found parted at 4 P.M. held
to the wind S.E. the middle and
Latter part the same and squally

Lat 4.58 S. Long 175.38 E

Tuesday Sept 30th

Begins with squally weather and
heading S.E. at 5 P.M. went ship
to the North the middle squally and
a plenty of rain at 9 A.M. Hove in
a gale and took in fore & main top sail
and spun from S.E. by night then
24 hours Lat 4.40 S. Long 175.08 E

Wednesday Oct 1st 1851

Begins with thick weather and under
short sail at 2 P.M. Moderate sea
and made sail heading N.N.E.
the middle and latter part wind from
N.E. and heading N.N.W. and fair weather
and saw nothing of note so ends

Lat 3.34 S. Long 176.59 E

Thursday Oct 2nd

Begins with a strong breeze from
N.E. and heading N.N.W. at 6 P.M.
Took ship to the S.E. the middle part
fair weather latter part Coopering Oil
to stay between Dick so ends then
24 hours Lat 4.44 S

Long 175.18 E.

Friday Oct 3rd 1851

Begins with fine weather wind from
S.E. and heading to the South at
5 P.M. Took ship to the North the
middle part fine latter the same and
stowing down Oil between Dick so ends
then 24 hours Lat 3.35 S. Long 175.30 E.

Saturday Oct 4th

Begins with fine weather and light
air from E. and heading to the N.E.
and stowing down at 4 P.M. finished
at 8 Shortened sail the weather a
little squally at 6 A.M. heading to the
South and saw whales at 8 Lowered for
them at 9 past 9 struck one and at
9 past 10 struck another 24 hours
then 24 hours Lat 3.38 S. Long 176.33 E.

Sunday Oct 5th

Begins squally and a whaling at 2
P.M. took the second whale along side
at 2 P.M. and at 3 cont cutting
at 6 finished and took in sail for
the night the middle part squally
and a plenty of rain at 6 A.M. the
weather better and cont cutting so ends
then 24 hours Lat 3.06 S. Long 174.56 E

Monday Oct 6th

Begins with a fresh breeze from S.E.
and sailing and heading S.E. under
short sail the middle part fine weather
at 5 A.M. Coold down and latter part
employed a mending the lower part
and Coopering Oil & so forth and
heading S.E. Lat 4.15 S.

Long 175.20 E.
