Begins with a fine breeze from E and heading to the South at 2 P.M. Took the Ship Atlantic of San Francisco 700 on board at 3 were ship to the North at 8 A.M. Saw whales of the weather Bow a young quick to the S.E. and a beating up to them at 10 Lowered the Atlantic in company she struck two and got them we struck one & the Iron Drum we got nothing Lat 3.56 S. Long 175.20 E.

Wednesday Oct 8th

Begins with a fine breeze and at 2 P.M. took up the Boat and the whale gone to windward at 5 P.M. Took Ship to the S.E. and took in Light sail the Middle and Latta part fine and saw nothing of note and heading to the S. Lat 3.57 S. Long 175.33 E.

Thursday Oct 9th

Begins with a fine trade and heading N.E. and at 5 P.M. Took Ship to the North the Middle part squally the Latta & Cooperine Oil to New Haven and so on Lat 3.51 S. Long 175.40 E.

Friday Oct 10th

Begins with squally weather and impley a Cooperine and stoping a Latta over the Bow at 2 P.M. started down the Oil between Sails at 6 were ship to the S.E. and E.N.E. the Middle and Latta part squally and heading E.S.E. so on 24 hours Lat 4.04 S. Long 176.00 E.

Saturday Oct 11th

Begins with squally weather and heading to the S.E. and the Atlantic under our Lee at 6 P.M. started sail for the Night the Middle and Latta part fine and heading N.E. and saw nothing of note Lat 4.05 S. Long 175.44 E.

Sunday Oct 12th

Begins with a Light sail from E.N.E. and heading N at 6 P.M. started sail for the night the Middle part calm Latta part a light breeze from S.E. and steering N. so on 24 hours Lat 5.53 S. Long 176.00 E.

Monday Oct 13th

Begins with a moderate breeze from S.E. and steering N at 6 P.M. Latta to the wind and started sail for the night the Latta part fine and saw one Ship to windward and no whales and steering of over the ground so on 24 hours Lat 3.07 S. Long 175.31 E.

Tuesday Oct 14th

Begins with a light sail from N.E. and at 1 P.M. saw something that we thought to be whales a long way off but could not get near enough to ascertain at 8 Left to and took in Light sail the Middle Calm at 4 past 5 P.M. saw many whales all round the Ship at 6 Lowered and hoisted and at 10 struck one and the Iron Drum and so on in chase 18 miles from the ship and a fat Calm and got nothing Lat 3.05 S. Long 175.16 E.
