Wednesday Oct 13th 1851
Began with calm weather and boats
of after whale at 2 then got on board
after an unsuccessful chase off
20 miles pull at 6 took in sail
for the night the middle squally of
rain the latter fair and a light air
from W. Lat 3.11 S. Long 175.05 E.

Thursday Oct 16th
Began with a light breeze from W.
and heading to the S. at 2 P.M. saw
a brush on the weather beam but
did not fire until what it was at 3
took in sail for the night the middle
and latter part a light breeze from S.W.
and steering N.W. Lat 3.13 S. Long 174.25

Friday Oct 17th
Began with fine weather and wind
from W. and S.W. and steering N.W.
at 4 P.M. wore ship to the S.E. and
took in sail at 6 the weather squally
the middle & latter part calm and at
work at ship duty about the rigging
and no whale. Lat 2.50 S. Long 174.19

Saturday Oct 18th
Began with calm weather and at
work a line up the main rigging
at 6 P.M. shortened sail for the night
the latter part fine weather and a light
breeze from N.W. and steering E.S.E. &
and no whale Lat 3.01 S. Long 174.25
Sunday Oct 19th

Began with fine weather and wind
from N.W. and steering E. at 6 P.M.
shortened sail and steer S.E. by E. the middle
and latter part a plenty of rain and
wind all around the compass and
steering to the eastward Lat 4.03 S. Long 175.50

Line
Monday Oct 20th 1851
Began with squally weather and a
plenty of rain and steering N.E. and E.
at 5 P.M. shortened sail for the night
the middle and latter part a light
air from E. and heading N. N.E. &
and saw nothing Lat 3.51 S. Long 175.18

Tuesday Oct 21th
Began with a light air from E. and
heading N.N.W. and nothing to be
seen the middle and latter part a fine
trade and nothing to be seen and heading
S.E. by S. Lat 3.40 S. Long 175.30 E.

Wednesday Oct 22th
Began with a fresh trade from E. and
heading S.E. and a light start in the
middle and latter part a strong trade
and heading S.E. by E. so cold and saw
nothing Lat 4.52 S. Long 176.06 E.

Thursday Oct 23th
Began with a strong trade and heading
N.E. by E. at 5 P.M. backed ship to the
North the middle and latter part
fine weather and saw nothing of note
so ends Lat 4.28 S. Long 175.52 E.

Friday Oct 24th
Began with a light breeze from N.E.
and heading to the North and nothing
to be seen the middle and latter part a
light air from the E. and one sail in sight

Saturday Nov 25th
Began with a light air from E. and heading
to the North and at 3 P.M. spoke the
General Combs of London 100 balls
the middle and latter part calm and
saw nothing of note so ends
Lat 4.14 S. Long 174.35 E.
