Thursday Nov 13th 1854

Begins with a fine breeze and heading
S by E. and at 10th whole watches the
middle and latter part a fine breeze
and steering S. E. and so well
saw nothing Lat 44.25 S Long 146.53 E
Friday Nov 14th

Begins with a strong breeze from
E and steering S. at 4 P.M. steering
S. E. W. and weather squally and
S by E in the middle part the sun
and latter part held up S. E. E.
so well squally Lat 46.12 S Long 145.25 E

Saturday Nov 15th

Begins with a light breeze from E. S. E.
and heading S. by the wind at 8 P.M.
heading S. E. by S the middle and latter
part squally and wind from E. by N. W. E.
and steering E. S. E. Lat 47.20 S Long 145.49 E

Sunday Nov 16th

Begins with squalls of wind and rain
from N. W. W. steering E. S. E. at 6
a heavy surf set the middle third and
at 2 P.M. took a strong breeze from W. N. W.
and steering E. S. E. and ends with a
fine breeze Lat 48.15 S Long 146.56 E

Monday Nov 17th

Begins with a light breeze from S. W.
and steering S. E. at 6 at noon at
7 a light breeze from E. S. E. the middle
and latter part a fine breeze from E.
and steering S. by E. S. E. and
so well Lat 49.13 S Long 147.03 E
Leaves 147.05 E

Bouira South

Thursday Nov 18th 1854

Begins with a fine breeze from E and
steering S. E. by S. at 4 P.M. steering
S. E. at 4 P.M. held up S. E. S. the latter
part squally and saw nothing wind
S. E. Lat 44.25 S Long 146.58 E
Leaves 146.53 E

Friday Nov 19th

Begins with a light breeze from E. S. E.
and steering S. E. by S. at 8 P.M. saw
the Island of Potomina bearing S. E. E.
a distance of 30 miles at 12 started sail
and stood of shore 2 hours & then stood in
at 9 P.M. got in with the lee end of the
Island and a working up and at 11
two canoes came off and so ended their
24 hours Lat 42.27 S Long 147.00 E

Saturday Nov 20th

Begins with a fine trade and beating up
to the Island at 4 P.M. stood of from the
harbour for the night at 7 P.M. went in
with two boats to trade and so ended
their 24 hours Lat 41.28 S Long 147.17 E

Sunday Nov 21th

Begins with a fine trade and two
boats on shore a trading at 8 P.M. got
6 boat loads and put away S. by E.
with a fresh trade and some squally
the middle the sun latter part light
and steering S. by E. Lat 43.40 S Long 147.48 E

Monday Nov 22th

Begins with a light breeze from E. S. E.
and heading S. the middle and latter part
light and steering S. by E. and hands
employed a cleaning the iron work out
side the ship so well Lat 44.32 S
Long 146.45 E
