at 11th ship. N.E. of Green Port came in
5 months out 100 Hll

Sun Feb 15th
Begins with fine weather and on
the middle & latter part a gale from the
North and so ends

Monday Feb 16th
Begins with gale from the North
and at 2 P.M. the ship James
of Nantucket came in with 12 Hll
& ship. Conner of Nantucket & 100 Hll
the latter part fine weather and
so ends

Tuesday Feb 17th
Begins with fine weather the latter
part the same

Wednesday Feb 18th
Begins with fine weather and we
watch on Liberty

Thursday Feb 19th
Begins with fine weather and the
latter part the same

Friday Feb 20th
Begins with fine weather and getting ready for sea

Saturday Feb 21st
Begins with fine weather and getting
ready for sea and at 11 the
blow came in with my floor
and took it on board

Sunday Feb 22nd
Begins fine and all day for sea
the latter part the same

Monday Feb 23rd
Begins with fine weather and
at 8 A.M. took anchor for sea at
St. Mark's Cape. Brit. barney &
and in company with the N.E. &
C. P. Morgan so ends a fine day from
S.E. Lat 35-05 S. Long 174-55 E

Tuesday Feb 24th
Begins with a fresh breeze from the
N.E. and steering N.E. & the Morgan
close by at 8 P.M. the latter the
middle part blowing strong and at 10
A.M. took in Main sail & 1/2 S.E. and
heading N.N.E. Lat 33-50 S. Long 175-20 W

Wednesday Feb 25th
Begins with a strong breeze from E. &
steering N.N.E. at 3 P.M. took in the
Fore & Main topsail at 4 P.M. a gale
and rain at 5 P.M. ship and looking
for sail & close reef the M. topsail
it blowing heavy with rain the middle
the same at 6 A.M. took up the boats &
was ship to the Eastward and wind S.E.
and blowing hard and a bad sea on Leeward
the 24 hours Lat 33-40 S. Long 175-30
