

About the Linnear Islands

Thursday June 10th 1852
Begins with a rain storm and a
flourish of thunder and lightning for
the Island and at 3 P.M. put across
N. by N. for Upolu and at 12 noon
I saw Mr. Meridian took the Pilot
on board and saw the Ship Gangs
of Rantuckit of the harbor with
1250 lbs. so much

Friday June 11th
Begins with fine weather and at
4 P.M. let go both anchors in
a fathoms of water in the harbor
of Upolu the Island of Upolu with
the Ship William & Henry of Fathoms
& Men out of hand

Saturday June 12th
Begins with fine weather and at
4 P.M. Ship Linnear came in with
1050 lbs of Lk and so much the
latter part rainy

Sunday June 13th
Begins with fine weather and
the latter part the same the latter
part Ship Ben Morris came in 1100 lbs

Monday June 14th
Begins with fine weather and at work
to landings along the Harbormast
the latter part the same

Tuesday June 15th
Begins with fine weather and at 8 A.M.
sent up the L. Linnear and so forth
to end

Wednesday June 16th
Begins with fine weather and at
work on Ship's Duty the latter part
the same

Upolu Navigator Island

Thursday June 17th
Begins with fine weather and at work on
fixing up rigging and so forth
the latter part a Coopering Oil so much

Friday June 18th
Begins with fine weather and at work
about the ship and storing down water
so forth Ship Linnear sailed

Saturday June 19th
Begins with fine weather and
the latter part the same & painting Pearl

Sunday June 20th
Begins with fine weather and the
latter part fine weather and one
watch on Liberty

Monday June 21th
Begins with fine weather and
one watch on Liberty and the other
a painting

Tuesday June 22th
Begins with fine weather and one watch
on Liberty and the rest at work on ship
duty

Wednesday June 23th
Begins with fine weather and one watch
on Liberty and the rest on ship's duty
the latter part the same

Thursday June 24th
Begins with fine weather and one
watch on Liberty and so much

Friday June 25th
Begins with fine weather and all
hands employed a getting more and storing
it away

Saturday June 26th
Begins with fine weather and all
hands employed about the ship or
storing up rigging and so forth
