

Ship Swift homeward bound
Sunday Oct 24th 1852

Begins with a fine trade from N.E.
Sturges N.W. and at 4 P.M. took in
Main Royal Top Mast and top sail
& parted the fly for Mast and
march another the middle and latter
part a fine trade and all sail
Lat 11.56 N Long 48.36
Monday Oct 25th

Begins with a fine trade from N.E.
and Sturges N.W. with all sail out
to the best advantage the middle
part the same latter part more
moderate and all hands employed
a taring down so much of the
24 board Lat 13.59 N Long 50.04
Tuesday Oct 26th

Begins with a fine trade from
N.E. by E. and Sturges N.W. by N.
and all hands employed a taring
down at 4 P.M. finished the
middle part a fine trade and latter
part at work cleaning ship inside
so much Lat 15.34 N Long 49.18
Wednesday Oct 27th

Begins with a brisk trade from
E. N.E. and Sturges N.W. by N.
and at work a cleaning ship
inside at 5 P.M. finished at 7
Saw one ship Sturges to the
S.W. the middle and latter part the
same and at work a mending the
sail Lat 17.38 N Long 51.07
Thursday Oct 28th

Begins with a fine trade from E. by N.
and Sturges N.W. by N. and a squally
sail at 5 P.M. finished at 7 and two top sails
the middle part squally & haphazard the
latter a fine trade Lat 19.19 N Long 52.25 W

Ship Swift homeward bound
Friday Oct 29th 1852

Begins with a fine trade from E. by N.
and at work painting yards at 5
P.M. wind all died away and weather
very thick and a great deal of
disturbing at 7 a light breeze from
S.W. Sturges N.W. by N. Stretches
sail in one ship in sight a
Sturges N.W. by N. the middle
part squally and wind from S.W.
to S.E. and latter part fine weather
and a breeze from S.E. Sturges N.W.
& painting ship out side so much
that it took Lat 20.09 N Long 53.30 W
Saturday Oct 30th

Begins with a light air from S.E.
and Sturges N.W. and painting
ship inside & out at 4 P.M. finish
the out side at 8. A squall from N.W.
and close hauled at 10 took a strong breeze
from E. S. E. and a plenty of rain &
the latter part dry and a painting in
side so much with a fine breeze from
S.E. Lat 21.04 N Long 54.31 W
Sunday Oct 31th

Begins with squally weather and
wind all round from E. to S. and
a great deal of rain & Sturges N.W.
the middle part heavy rains and
latter part a fine breeze from S.E. and
fair weather Lat 22.07 N Long 56.04 W
Monday Nov 1st 1852

Begins with thick weather and a
breeze from S. Sturges N.W. by W. and
at 5 P.M. very squally at 7 wind from
W. and heading N. N. W. and rain
light sails in the middle and latter part
a fine breeze and all sail on Sturges N.W.
& N.W. by W. in sight Lat 23.05 N Long 57.18 W
