

Ship Swift homeward bound
Tuesday Nov 2th 1852.
Begins with a light breeze from N.E.
and during N.W. in company with
a bark at 5 P.M. wind W. N.W. &
heading N. the middle part a light
air from N.E. and latter the same
breeze from S.E. and implied a fair
weather fine Lat 28.49 N. Long 57.34

Wednesday Nov 3th
Begins with a light air from S.E.
and during N.W. and a bark in
company heading the same way
the middle part calm latter part
a light air from E. and a ship &
bark in sight heading to the N.W.
and hands employed about ship deck
a fairing & smooth Lat 24.12 N. Long 58.37

Thursday Nov 4th
Begins with a light air from E.
and a fairing about the ship &
during N.W. with all sail out the
middle and latter part a fine breeze
from N.N.E. and two sail in
sight so well Lat 24.44 N. Long 59.36

Friday Nov 5th
Begins with a fresh breeze from N.N.E.
and during N.W. at 5 P.M. hauled
to N.E. and a strong breeze at 7 took
in 4 x Mizen topsail and 3 sail
in sight the middle and latter part a
fine breeze and all sail out so
well there 2 1/2 hours Lat 25.12 N. Long 61.48

Saturday Nov 6th
Begins with a fine breeze from N.N.E. and
during N.W. by N. the middle part the
same latter part bent 4 x main topsail & fore sail
and a light breeze from N.N.E. and not
very much Lat 27.01 N. Long 62.45

Ship Swift homeward bound
Sunday Nov 7th 1852
Begins with a light breeze from N.N.E.
& during N.W. by N. and N.W. as the
wind baffled & all sail out and weather
fine the middle and latter part a
very light air and going about 1 knot
in hour Lat 27.22 N. Long 63.23

Monday Nov 8th
Begins with a light air from
S.E. & during N.W. and two
sail in sight a fine and we
making little headway and then
the storm the latter part a light
air from the S. and during N.W.
and N.E. as the wind baffled the latter
part implied a windier the breeze
top sail and 3 sail during N.W. &
and a very light air and two sail in
sight Lat 28.01 N. Long 63.46

Tuesday Nov 9th
Begins with a light air from S.E.
and during N.W. and at 5 P.M.
bent Mizen topsail and shifted over
standing sail & during N.W. with
a faint air and not much prospect of
weather to night 4 sail in sight
the middle part a light air and baffled
all the way from S. to E. and latter
part the same and three sail in
sight Lat 28.52 N. Long 64.07

Wednesday Nov 10th
Begins with a light air from S.W.
and during N.W. at 5 P.M. hauled
up N.W. the N. and then sail in sight
going to the N.E. the middle and latter
part a fine breeze and 3 sail in sight
at Meridian took in standing sails and from
th. Lat 30.19 N. Long 65.10
