

Ship Swift homeward bound
Thursday Nov 14th 1852
Begins with a fine breeze from
W and weathers thick at 2 P.M.
wind held to the S. at 4 P.M.
Ship and wind S. S. E. at 8
heading up. N. W. by S. used the
weather being the middle part
fresh winds from N. E. & E. N. E. &
thence N. W. by N. both parts
the same and on ship in
sight at 4 P.M. the same
way Lat 32.05 N. Long 66.35 W.

Friday Nov 15th
Begins with a fresh breeze from
N. E. by E. and thence N. S. W.
and all sail out and one ship
on the weather beam during the
same way the middle part a fine
breeze from S. and all sail out the
latter part wind S. and thick weather
one sail in view Lat 33.59 N. Long 68.08

Saturday Nov 16th
Begins with a fresh breeze from S.
and thence N. S. W. at 4 shifted over
stretching sails and held S. W. by S.
3 sail in sight the middle part squally
and wind held to S. and thence
thence all light sails in and reef
M. M. M. Top sail at 2 P.M. were ship
to the N. W. and at 4 made new
sail the weather fair the latter part
at heading W. N. W. an W. to end 1 sail
in sight Lat 35.23 N. Long 69.35 W.

Sunday Nov 17th 1852
Begins with a light breeze from N. S. W.
and thence W. & W. by S. and the wind
very lapping the middle part a strong breeze from
N. W. and at 4 a gale & have to reef close reef main
top sail & spinnaker heading W. S. W. Lat 35.10 S. Long 70.20

Ship Swift homeward bound
Monday Nov 18th 1852
Begins with a heavy gale from N. W.
& going to heading W. S. W. & under close
reef main top sail & two spinnakers & 7 P.M. they saw
and a very bad sea on the middle part
moderate sun and a plenty of squalls
at 9 A.M. set close reef & 10 P.M. main sail
heading W. S. W. at Meridian. over
ship to the North and past a ship
going on the weather took so much
the 24 hours Lat 35.24 N. Long 71.20 W.

Tuesday Nov 19th
Begins with a strong wind from
N. W. & heavy squalls & heading from
N. S. E. to N. W. under close reef &
10 P.M. courses and not making
much headway the middle part
very squally and took in 10 P.M. & 11 P.M.
at 4 P.M. set then the weather
fair and at 8 P.M. heading the top
works over board and at 10 made
new sail the weather fair but wind
abrad so much Lat 35.30 N. Long 72.25
Long 70.25

Wednesday Nov 20th
Begins with fine weather and N. W.
and lapping and main top sail set
1 P.M. 10 P.M. on heading from N. to N. E.
the middle part fine and at 8 P.M. took
ship to the N. W. and all sail out and
1 sail in sight so much with light
air from N. S. W. heading W. and
employed a gale in weather out
Lat 37.12 N. Long 73.20 W.
