 squalls 8 am calm until 6 pm light
 breeze all sail out heading East
 by North in Play in shifting water
 nothing in sight so Ends
 Lat 35.43 Long 39.06

Sept 9th 1908
 this day begins with fair weather
 calm nothing in sight J. Turner under
 short sail men in play in ship's duty
 and little fog as to ship's duty
 at 7 pm light squalls
 so Ends
 Lat 35.47 Long 39.07

Sept 10th 1908
 this day begins with clear weather
 light breeze all sail out until sun
 set calm men in play in ship's duty
 nothing in sight so Ends
 Lat 35.53 Long 48.48

Sept 11th this day begins with fair weather light breeze
 all sail out starting East men in play
 in ship's duty took in main sail at 4.30 pm
 wind West nothing in sight so Ends
 Lat 36.08 Long 38.28

Sept 12 this day begins with clear weather
 light breeze from East starting East
 one steamer in sight and one sailing
 ship men in play in ship's duty at 4 pm
 all sail out did out calm at sun set
 all sail in but the fore stay sail
 so Ends
 Lat 36.22 Long 38.09

Sept 13th this day begins with fair weather
 light breeze from South all sail out
 & schooner heading East by South men in
 play in ship's duty three steamers in
 sight so Ends
 Lat 36.30 Long 38.12

Sept 14 this day begins with fair
 weather all sail out in play in
 looking out spoke steamer rose
 banked back from Liverpool one
 bark in sight men in play in
 ship's duty J. Turner heading
 East by South wind from
 South West so Ends
 Lat 36.50 Long 37.02
