Oct 15 this day begins with fair weather strong
Breeze under fore sail Jib and stay sail and
main try sail took two men in brava
leve at 9 am heading south west men
play in ship duty nothing in sight at
7 pm light winds from north so ends
Lat 1439 Long 2410

Oct 16 this day begins with fair weather
and light north east winds first part of
the day all sail flew the main sail at 8
pm all sail out took in at 8 pm men
play in ship duty making two blocks
for fore stay sail sheet and other
Jobs as to ship duty so ends
Lat 1329 Long 2455

Oct 17 this day begins with fair weather light
breezes all sail out this day T. Turner head-
ing south west at 3 pm calm men in
play in ship duty rove a new fore stay
sail sheet and a shive for fore gaff
nothing in sight so ends
Lat 1220 Long 2515

Oct 18 this day begins with fair weather calm
under short sail heading south west men in
play in ship duty sand black fish got two
small ones nothing in sight 8 pm light
breeze made little more sail unread still
sick manual fell and hurt his leg so ending
so ends Lat 1157 Long 2526

Oct 19 this day begins with fair weather
8 am light rain and strong breeze T. Turner
under all sail heading south south
west shorting sail at 3 pm men in
ship duty one barge in sight so ends
Lat 1034 Long 2540

Oct 20 1908

this day begins with cloudy weather rain
squalls calm T. Turner under short sail until
11 am made all sail heading south in play in
cleaning ship by boiling black fish and Jibs
as to ship duty capturing sick one steamer
in sight so ends
Lat 1024 Long 2533

Oct 21 this day begins with
fair weather until 2 pm rain squall and modest
calm sand black fish loaded one boat no change
fore top sail halyard parted rove a new one
nothing in sight T. Turner heading south
south west unread still sick cold on the
lungs capturing all so sick so ends
Lat 8.10 Long 2458

Oct 22 this day begins with fair weather calm
T. Turner under short sail sand black
fish loaded one boat no change in play in
slushing masts and painting back stays
two ships in sight one man in irons for
bad behavior so ends
Lat 7.52 Long 2512

Oct 23 this day begins with
fair weather calm T. Turner under
fore stay sail in play in small Jobs
as to ship duty at sun set light
breeze all sail out heading south
by East two ships still in sight
man still in irons so ends
Lat 7.52 Long 2450

Oct 24 this day begins with fair weather calm
T. Turner under short sail in play in small Jobs
as to ship duty eight ships in sight spoke
for ship Dechmont of green oak bound to
sidney man still in irons painting back
stays and top masts rigging so ends
