Nov this day begins with squally weather calm rain to tender under short sail until 9 am sail light breeze 4 pm fresh breeze took in all top sails men in play in ship's duty warehoused winds to tender heading south west unread is how the same still sick nothing in sight so ended

Novth 5 this day begins with clear weather light winds from south west to tender under all sail cloudy 2 pm rain 7 pm thunder storm to tender heading west by south in play in little 8 as to ship's duty men in play in ship's duty nothing in sight unread still sick so ended
Lat 44 35 Long 24 30

Novth 6 this day begins with squally weather rain calm to tender under all sail heading west 4 pm light breeze all sail out heading south west by west men in play in ship's duty small Jals as to ship's duty unread still sick nothing in sight so ended
Lat 42 22 Long 24 53

Novth 7 this day begins with fair weather fresh breeze to tender under all sail heading south west by west in play in little Jals as to ship's duty stood today Jals and fore stay sail in a cask nothing in sight unread still sick so ended
Lat 25 9 Long 26 08

Novth 8 this day begins with fair fresh weather strong breeze to tender under all sail heading south west men in play in ship's duty nothing in sight unread still sick so ended
Lat 00 58 Long 27 44

Novth 9 1908

this day begins with cloudy weather strong breeze all sail out this day to tender under all sail heading south west men in play in ship's duty repair main top sail rone and sheet and so on unread still sick nothing in sight at 10 am saw a bergue going north east so ended
Lat 54 south Long 28 57

Novth 10 this day begins with fair weather moderate weather this day to tender under all sail heading south south west in play in small Jals as to ship's duty unread still sick don't improve any saw hump back nothing in sight so ended
Lat 50 5 Long 30 43

Novth 11 this day begins with clear weather strong winds to tender under all sail shorting sail at 9 am made all sail 4 pm shorting again 8 30 pm made a storm sail for S. L. men in play in ship's duty unread still sick one steamer in sight so ended this day
Lat 44 Long 30 48

Novth 12 this day begins with fair weather light breeze to tender under all sail heading south west by south 8 am saw black fish got three in play in cut ing them up unread still sick and other Jals as to ship's duty nothing in sight so ended
Lat 8 05 Long 31 08

Nov 12 mark all the irons in the boat's schooner name and date boat it belong to to L. L. to W. L. to S. L.
