this day begins with fair weather fresh breeze raged to downer under short sail fore sail try sail and head sails in play in shifting water men in play in ship duty nothing in sight to downer heading east by south 50 fathoms

Nov 24 this day begins with fair weather fresh breeze men in play in ship duty raise whales 6 am larder 9 am got one large one l.b. struck got along side the ship 3 pm lagoon to cut hair the piece for tomorrow to downer under try sail and fore stay sail 50 fathoms
Lat 1808 Long 3656

Nov 25 this day begins with squally weather light rain in play in cutting the cutting falls parted row a new one signal line shot to a steamer 12 am finish cutting 6 pm lagoon to bail at 6 pm unrad still sick no better 50 fathoms
Lat 1831 Long 3713

Nov 26 this day begins with cloudy weather hailing breaking out shifting water men in play in ship duty nothing in sight broke out free and 50 unrad still sick no better 50 fathoms this day
Lat 1900 Long 3717

Nov 27 this day begins with fair weather finish hailing 4 pm standing down broke out and small Jolbs as to ship duty one barge in sight going north east to downer under all sail heading north east 50 fathoms
Lat 1925 Long 3750

Nov 28 1908

this day begins with fair weather to downer under all sail heading first north west then north by west sun set shorting sail finish stand down 10 am men in play in ship duty two sails in sight unrad still sick 50 fathoms
Lat 1840 Long 3609

Nov 29 this day begins with cloudy weather clear of at 10 am to downer under short sail heading south south east men in play in ship duty unrad still sick no better nothing in sight 50 fathoms this day
Lat 1732 Long 3614

Nov 30 this day begins with fair weather light breeze to downer under short sail made sail 8 am shorting sail again at sun set one barge in sight in play in setting rigging and another small Jolbs one steamer in sight all 50 men in play in ship's duty 50 fathoms this day
shushing mabbs Lat 1807 Long 3630

December first this day begins with fair weather raise whales 6 am larder l.b. got one small one got a long side 12 am finish cutting made fire 6 pm men in play in ship's duty nothing in sight 50 fathoms
Lat 1823 Long 3638

Dec 2 this day begins with fair weather fresh breeze finish hailing 12 am to downer under all sail heading east by N. south men in play in ship duty broke boat clearer William looped put another man in his place manual 4 sails in sight 50 fathoms this day
