This day begins with fair weather light breeze to hatter under all sail raise whales lowered at 12 am I got one got a long side 4.30 had on cat untill dark in play in ship's duty nothing in sight so ends

Dec 14 this day begins with fair weather light breeze in play in cutting lost the head towner under short sail finish cutting 12 am made fire 2 pm men in play in ship's duty nothing in sight so ends
Lat 17.47 Long 36.36

Dec 15 this day begins with fair weather towner under all sail but the fore sail hailing men in play in ship's duty raise whales 9.30 am lower sb and lb I got one got a long side 5 pm sb hailing one steamer in sight calm so ends this day
Lat 17.42 Long 36.40

Dec 16 this day begins with fair weather light breeze towner under short sail cutting finish at 9 am spoke steamer The A. Trecarrell going to Buenos Ayres begins to boil 12 am men in play in ship's duty sounding down at 5 pm made more sail heading east so ends
Lat 17.40 Long 37.05

Dec 17 this day begins with fair weather light breeze all sail out hailing finish 9 am 12 am set the fore sail men in play in ship's duty nothing in sight took in the Jib top sail at sun set clear and breeze so ends
Lat 18.22 Long 36.24

Dec 18 1908

This day begins with fair weather light breeze towner under all sail heading south east by east in play in standing down men in play in ship's duty broke out flow and park nothing in sight so ends
Lat 17.47 Long 36.14

Dec 19 this day begins with fair weather light breeze towner under all sail men in play in ship's duty repair in the cutting stage and other jobs to ship's duty nothing in sight home to under main sail and fore sail stay sail heading east north east so ends
Lat 18.02 Long 35.40

Dec 20 this day begins with fair weather moderate breeze all sail out men in play in ship's duty raise whales lower 9.30 am got a long side 11.30 I got one cut in made fire 7 pm nothing in sight so ends
Lat 18.10 Long 36.20

Dec 21 this day begins with fair weather towner under all sail but the fore sail hailing men in play in ship's duty shorting sail at sun set two sails in sight towner heading north finish hailing at 9 pm boat stainer took his things forward with out any go telling him to do so so ends Lat 18.27 Long 35.53

Dec 22 this day begins with fair weather towner under all sail men in play in ship's duty standing down sail finish 10 am nothing in sight shorting sail at sun set home to heading north one steamer in sight 6 pm so ends this day
