this day begins with fair weather fresh breeze this day towner under all sail but the main sail saw black fish got one in ploy in painting gaffs and boom saw a large whale going fast 4:30 pm men in ploy in ship duty one ship in sight ends

March 10th this day begins with fresh breeze raged weather this day towner under all sail but the main sail in ploy in ship duty men in ploy in small Tobs as to ship duty all so hauling a black fish nothing in sight towner heading North under short sail so ends this day
Lat 13 48 Long 40 35

March 11th this day begins with fresh breeze raged this day towner under all sail 7 am rais whales 6:30 am going quick toward no chance men in ploy in ship duty shorting sail 5 pm towner under head sails fore sail and main try sail heading North no sails in sight so ends
Lat 13 50 Long 40 44

March 12th this day begins with fresh breeze towner under all sail rais whales 10 am toward sb struck and sb line parted sb got a m all one got a long side 3 pm cut in 3 pm finish 4 pm in ploy in ship duty scrapping main boom shorting sail at 6 pm towner heading north so ends
Lat 14 00 Long 41 00

March 13th 1909

this day begins with strong breeze raged heavy sea towner under fore and main try sail heading south east made fire 9 am finish 5 pm men in ploy in ship duty nothing in sight broke out flour and other Tobs 30 ends
Lat 14 Long 40 52

March 14th this day begins with fair weather strong breeze towner under fore sail main try sail heading south west at 6 pm took in head sails hove to under fore sail and main try sail men in ploy in ship duty nothing in sight so ends
Lat 19 03 Long 40 56 15

March 15th this day begins with cloudy weather light rain fresh breeze this day towner under all sail but the main sail heading west North west in ploy in small Tobs as to ship duty men in ploy in ship duty took in all head 6 pm hove to under fore sail and main try sail heading south east so ends
Lat 12 45 Long 41 47

March 16th this day begins with cloudy weather strong breeze this day towner under head sail fore sail and main try sail heading west North west in ploy in small Tobs as to ship duty all so dashing paint nothing in sight so ends this day
Lat 12 25 Long 42 48 45

March 17th this day begins with fair weather trades winds this day towner under fore sail head sails main try sail fore top sail heading west North west men in ploy in scrapping and painting nothing in sight so ends this day
Lat 12 30 Long 45 23
