April 11th this day towner lying to anchor in dominica strong breeze 45 fathoms of chain out men in play in ship duty one watch on shore so ends this day

April 12th this day towner lying to anchor in dominica fresh breeze men in play in ship duty made one cask of matter and little Jobs as to ship duty so ends this day

April 13th this towner lying to anchor in dominica at 5 am hall a long side three mack schooner in play in this charding oil coppering and refilling men in play in ship duty so ends

April 14 this day towner along side breeston breeze mack discharging oil and receiving flour and beef and other small packages as to ship stowage men in play in ship duty one watch on shore so ends this day

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April 15 this day towner still along side three mack schooner strong breeze in play in making out finish 10 am finish discharging at 1 pm and receiving ship stowage level along side the sch at 4 pm went to anchor 4 30 pm so ends this day

April 16 this day towner lying to anchor in dominica men in play in ship duty coppering cask and stowing down and small Jobs as to ship duty so ends this day

April 17 this day towner still lying to anchor in dominica men in play in ship duty in play in coppering cask and stowing down and making matter finish stowing the ground tare coppering flour and bread so ends

April 18 this day towner still to anchor in dominica men in play in ship duty one watch on shore so ends this day

April 19th mon this day towner still to an anchor in dominica & stowing cask and taking water getting ready for sea men in play in ship duty one watch on shore at 6 pm so ends this day

April 20th this day towner still in port dominica in play in stowing taking water and wood and some small Jobs as to ship duty two men were on shore on 19 and has not return as yet and the stowaway boy Jim Taylor so ends this day
