

May 19 1909

this day begins with fair weather this day
tender under all sail rais whales landward
got one got a long 10 am finish cutting at
12:30 am men in play in ship duty made fire
at 4 pm tender heading North North east
two schooners in sight so ends this day
Lat 37 46 Long 72 44 15

May 20th this day begins with fair weather
in play in hauling rais whales landward two
boats - got one got a long side at 10 am
cut in at 1 pm finish at 3:30 pm made
fire 10 pm one schooner in sight hauling
stow down a little oil so ends this day
Lat 37 47 Long 72 43

May 21st

this day begins with fair weather
8 am fresh east winds ruff cool down
at 12 am made more sail set the fore
try sail and fore stay sail and a lub Jib
heading south east blowing quite fresh
men in play in ship duty one sail in sight
so ends this day no sight Lat 37 47 Long 72 43

May 22nd this day begins with cloudy
weather and fog tender under fore and
main try sail and fore stay sail
made fire 12 am finish at 4 pm men
in play in ship duty one sail in sight
ruff tender heading east south east
so ends this day Lat 37 56 Long 73 47

May 23 this day begins with cloudy weather
blowing hard this day tender under fore
and main try sail and fore stay sail
no sight heading east by North ruff and whales
cloudy in the morning and at 4 pm saw them a
gain going south west one sch in sight
so ends this day

May 24

this day begins with fair weather light breeze
at 12 am tender under all sail spoke sch
elm swift one large in sight hauling men
in play in ship duty saw a merchant boat bottom
up mend the flying Jib and other small Jibs
to ho to under fore and main try sail and
fore stay sail so ends this day
Lat 37 27 Long 73 37

May 25th this day begins with fair weather
tender under all sail men in play in ship
duty rais whales at 10 am tender S. got
me S. h. two got a long side 1:30 pm
begin to cut 3 pm finish at 4 pm two
whaling ships in sight so ends this day
Lat 37 47 Long 72 52

May 26th this day begins with cloudy weather
light winds tender under short sail
men in play in hauling men in play in ship
duty five sails in sight at 7 pm light
rains shorting down all to fore stay sail
and main try sail calm so ends
Lat 37 Long 74

May 27th this day begins with cloudy weather
and rain tender under fore stay sail and main
try sail in play in hauling stop hauling
at 8 am begin again at 9 am finish at
12 am rain again until 6 pm standing
oil men in play in ship duty 8 pm fog
no sight tender heading east saw the east so ends

May 28 this day begins with cloudy weather
this day tender under short sail rais whales
at 12 am landward S. got one cut in
one schooner in sight whaling & tender
heading south east under main try sail fore stay
sail and Jib - so ends this day
