

May 29 1909

This day begins with fair weather tower under all sail but the fore sail and fore top sail rais whales got one 8 lb in ploy in hauling and cutting men in ploy in ship duty one sail in sight other Jobs as to ship duty shifting water so ends

May 30 this day begins with fair weather this day tower under all sail working to the west ward in ploy in shifting water and stowing oil men in ploy in ship duty one 8 lb in sight hauling tower took in fore and main top sail at 12 am all lower sails out heading North west by North so ends this day
Lat 38 21 Long 71 49

May 31 this day begins with fair weather light winds this day tower under all sail in ploy in ship duty small Jobs as to ship duty one three mass 8 lb in sight step a clark in the main sail shorting sail at sun set heading North west by North so ends
Lat 38 00 Long 72 32-30

June 1st the first this day begins with fair weather light breeze tower under all sail heading first to south west then to North west at 4 pm calm two sails in sight men in ploy in small Jobs as to ship duty saw a few black fish shorting sail at sun set so ends this day
Lat 38 00 Long 73 00

June 2 this day begins with cloudy weather and thunder and rain tower under all lower sails in ploy in small Jobs as to ship duty shorting sail 2 pm took in main sail and Jib top sail at 7 pm took in fore sail and Jib set the fore try sail ready so ends this day
Lat 37 55 Long 73 00

June 3 this day begins with thick fog calm this day tower under short sail in ploy in small Jobs as to ship duty making a hauling try sail at 4 am a steamer past close to heading north east 6 pm purcy m. simons and ansets Ramos had a fight put louth in irons tower under fore and main try sail and fore stay sail nothing in sight so ends
Lat 38 00 Long 72 56

June 4 this day begins with fog at 7 am rain tower under fore and main try sail and fore stay sail men in ploy in ship duty nothing in sight calm rain untill 6 pm took purcy out of irons and Ramos at 6 pm so ends no sight
Lat North Long West

June 5 this day begins with thick fog tower under short sail fore and main try sail heading North east men in ploy in ship duty at 12 o'clock at 12 30 pm thick a gain broke out ships and other Jobs as to ship duty clear a gain at 7 30 pm one steamer in sight thick men on duty Alburth screw hart and peater swabs so ends
