

July 4th 1909

This day begins with fair weather in play in cutting finish 2.30 pm men in play in ship's duty begins to hail 3.30 pm took in the main sail 6 pm turned under Jib fore stay sail and main try sail heading east by south nothing in sight 50 fathoms
Lat 33° 18' Long 152° 21'

July 5th this day begins with clear weather fresh breeze this day turned under head sails and main sail in play in hauling men in play in ship's duty breaking out shifting water nothing in sight shorting sail 4 pm main sail and Jib fore stay sail out heading east by south 50 fathoms
Lat 33° 21' Long 152° 20'

July 6th this day begins with clear weather hauling until 7 am turned under all sail until 4 pm shorting sail heading west by north men in play in ship's duty standing down and small Jibs as to ship's duty one hauled in sight 50 fathoms
Lat 33° 14' Long 152° 19'

July 7th this day begins with clear weather fresh breeze turned under fore sail Jib fore stay sail and try sail in play in standing sail finish 7 am men in play in ship's duty shorting sail at sunset fore and main try sail fore stay sail out heading south east nothing in sight 50 fathoms
Lat 33° 19' Long 152° 30'

July 8th

This day begins with sunny weather ruff sea south west winds turned under short sail in play in repairing fore and main sail and other Jibs as to ship's duty one sail in sight turned under fore and main try sail fore stay sail and Jib heading west north west 50 fathoms
Lat 33° 08' Long 152° 15'

July 9th this day begins with cloudy weather raged in play in mending the cutting stage rais whales 3.30 pm got one & 1/2 lb got a long side 8 pm shorting sail men in play in ship's duty nothing in sight 50 fathoms
Lat 33° 10' Long 152° 15'

July 10th this day begins with cloudy weather rain in play in cutting finish 4 pm men in play in ship's duty nothing in sight shorting sail at sunset made fire 5 pm turned under head sail and try sail hauling 50 fathoms
Lat 33° 35' Long 152° 15'

July 11th this day begins with cloudy weather light breeze turned under short sail hauling breaking out men in play in ship's duty shifting water nothing in sight 50 fathoms this day
Lat 33° 35' Long 152° 15'

July 12th this day begins with clear weather calm turned under short sail hauling finish at 9 am men in play in ship's duty standing and cooper in cask and other Jibs as to ship's duty turned heading south east fore stay sail and main try sail out 50 fathoms
Lat 33° 53' Long 152° 25'
