July 23 this day begins with cloudy  
weather rain squalls towner under head  
sails fore sail and main try sail in  
in small Sols as to ship duty short  
ing sail at 7 pm men in play in  
ship duty nothing in sight so ends  
Lat 3332 Long 5156

July 24 this day begins with cloudy weather  
and rain squalls this day towner under  
fore and main try sail fore and fore  
stay sail men in play in small Sols  
as to ship duty nothing in sight so ends  
no log no log Lat 3320 Long 5200

July 25 this day begins with cloudy  
weather towner under all sail light  
winds from the east rain squalls  
rain from 2 am to 4 pm calm shorting  
sail 12 am took in fore sail at 7 pm  
fore and main try sail out heading  
east North east fore and fore stay sail out  
so ends Lat 3320 Long 5210

July 26 this day begins with squally  
weather until 2 pm rain squalls under  
3 pm starboard boat got one got a  
long side at 11 pm light breeze short  
ing sail have to men in play in ship  
duty nothing in sight so ends

July 27 1909

This day begins with clear weather light  
breeze towner under main sail and fore stay  
sail in play in cutting begin 5 am finish  
at 3 pm men in play in ship duty made  
fire 5 pm of Spade steamer to log helms and  
put a letter on board so ends this day  
Lat 3400 Long 5106

July 28 this day begins with fair weather  
light breeze towner under all sail but  
the fore sail heading west men in play in  
ship duty hauling and breaking out  
sheeting water took in main top  
sail 6 pm nothing in sight so ends  
Lat 3407 Long 5110

July 29 this day begins with cloudy weather  
light rain in play in hauling finish at 5  
am blowing air towner under all sail  
took in main sail 1 pm fore sail fore  
and fore stay sail and main try sail  
out heading south men in play in ship  
duty nothing in sight so ends this day  
Lat 3406 Long 5111

July 30 this day begins with cloudy  
weather in play in standing down finish at  
9 am towner under all sail raise d-hales 10  
30 under 12 30 S. B. got one got a long side  
10 pm shorting sail have to heading  
south light rain so ends this day  
no sight

July 31 this day begins with cloudy weather  
in play in cutting finish at 2 pm last  
the head shorting sail 6.30 pm on the  
same tack heading south begin to  
hail 6 pm nothing in sight so ends
