under fore sail main by sail and head sail
so ends

Comes with good breeze from NE hazy
weather course S.W. middle and latter part
weather the same on boat the mainsail
and commence step some cloths in and some
of the men making a boat sail so ends

Thursday Oct 28th Lat by log 14:40 ^{Long 25:45}
Comes with fresh trades hazy weather
crew employed repairing the mainsail
and making a boat sail middle and latter
part moderate down so ends

Friday Oct 29th Lat 13:15 Long 25:00
Comes with light trades equally looking
weather Capt repaired W.B. and the
crew employed repairing the mainsail
and working on boat sail middle
and latter heavy rain so ends

Saturday Oct 30th No Ob
Comes with plenty rain wind S.E. to
South laying along under short sail
heading S. to S.W. middle and latter
moderate baffling winds employed fixing
the mainsail so ends

Sunday Oct 31st Lat 11:06 Long 25:09
Comes with baffling winds from S to S.E. at 4 P.M.
finish repairing the mainsail and bend
middle part calm latter part light air
